- Necessary Paperwork for Kindergarten
 - What if I registered at another school?
- How to report an excused absence?
- How to request an educational excused absence?
- What counts as a full day?



Mitzi Searcy, School Nurse

- Medications
 - Parents have to bring in and pick up medicines (<u>DO NOT</u> send with your child!)
 - Parent AND Health Care Professional must complete AND sign Form 1702
 - Medicines must come in their original container with the prescription label
- Health Plans
- Kindergarten Health Assessments and Immunizations records must be turned in by September 25th, 2018 or students will be excluded from school.

- Families must "opt in" to text messages by texting "Yes" to the number 67587. You will receive a confirmation text for the cell phone on record, unless your phone is already linked.
