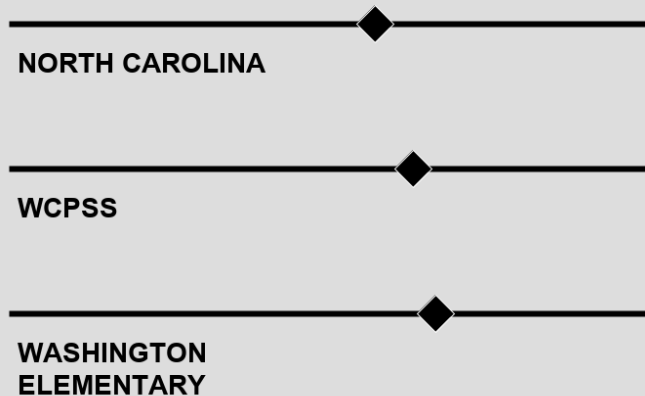

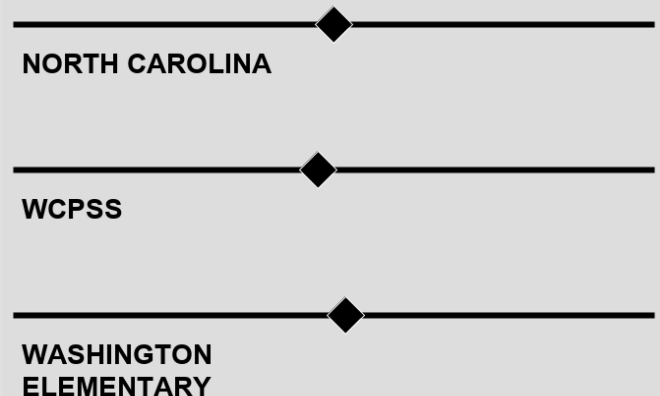
## HOW WE COMPARE
