CAMPAIGNING AND NEW INFORMATION

2019-2020 Election Dates

- ▶ Interest Meeting: Sep. 5 in Room 1238
- ▶ Application due: Sep. 9 by 2:30 pm to Ms. Wooten (Room 1238)
- ▶ Campaigning: Sep 10-16
- ▶ President and Vice President written speeches due: Sep. 10
- ▶ President and Vice President written speeches returned: Sep. 13
- ▶ President and Vice President Speeches: Sep. 16 in auditorium
- ▶ Elections: Sep. 16 during homeroom
- ▶ Results: Candidates should be in Room 1238 before first period (7 AM) for results on Wednesday, Sep. 18. Names will be announced to school during second period announcements.
- ▶ First meeting for complete 19-20 Student Council: Sep. 24 after school in Room 1238

Campaign Rules

- ▶ Each candidate may have up to three posters on poster board. No posters can be bigger than a size of normal poster board.
- ▶ Posters need to arrive in my room (1238) before first period to get approved on Sep. 10. They will be ready to be hung during lunch. If any poster is hung without my approval and initial in corner, it will be taken down.
- ▶ Posters can ONLY be hung in the cafeteria and the front hall. DO NOT HANG POSTERS ON DRYWALL!
- ▶ No balloons or items that can cause a distraction can be put on posters...too much weight makes them fall anyway.
- ▶ Poster putty and Command Strips are the only proven adhesives to work so far...
- ▶ No favors like candy or food can be handed out. No pamphlets or stickers. Buttons, pencils, wristbands, and wearing T-Shirts are ok.
- ▶ Positive campaign tactics ONLY! Social media IS allowed...but be careful!
- ▶ No parents!
- ▶ All posters must be removed from walls by end of day on Wednesday, Sep. 18 (day results are announced)

Who is Running for What...

- ▶ Add your name to the proper section for the position you are running for in the election.
- ▶ Make sure you print your name...and it is legible.
- ▶ This sign will hang outside Ms. Wooten's room (1238) through the end of the day on Sep. 9 (application due date).
- ▶ Please check these and be sure of the position you would like to run for...and those you will be running against.
- ▶ You cannot change your position after this date. If positions are not filled, then they will remain unfilled for the school year...so be smart in choosing!
