

# Leesville Road High School Student Handbook Addition on ACADEMIC INTEGRITY

## **Purpose**

Leesville Road High School's mission is **to inspire students' love for learning and ensure that they have the necessary skills to be self-reliant citizens who can think critically and solve future challenges**. An adherence to academic honesty and integrity is vital to producing self-reliant citizens and ensures that schoolwork accurately reflects student learning. Cheating and plagiarism violate ethical and moral rules of conduct as well as Board Policy 6410. Additionally, these behaviors inhibit a student's ability to reach his/her academic potential and compromise the trust between teacher and student. Each student, parent, and staff member has a responsibility to promote an academic culture that respects and fosters individual achievement.

# The Honor Code

At Leesville Road High School I am expected to conduct myself honorably in pursuit of academic excellence; thus, I will not cheat or plagiarize.

## **Definitions and Examples**

**Cheating -** *Defined as receiving or giving unauthorized assistance on academic work that may be used as a graded assessment for any course/subject.* 

#### Examples include but are not limited to:

- Copying answers from another student's quiz/test
- Providing or using unauthorized notes, data, or other aids, such as dictionaries, calculators, cell phones, or other electronic devices, during quizzes or tests
- Copying another student's work, either in part or in its entirety
- Allowing someone to copy work
- Pressuring someone to provide his/her homework or assignment for the purpose of copying
- Using electronic devices/social media to share or receive unauthorized information
- Relaying assessment content, questions, or answers to students who have not yet taken the assessment

**Plagiarizing -** *Defined as copying the language, structure, or ideas of another (in whole or in part) and representing it as one's own work.* 

#### Examples include but are not limited to:

- Copying material directly from published material or a website without providing documentation and a works cited/bibliography
- Turning in an assignment or project that was written in part or in entirety by someone else
- Making up sources or including sources not contained in the works cited page
- Altering, restating, or paraphrasing another person's words, ideas, or work without giving credit or acknowledging the source (including but not limited to text, music and video clips, photos, graphics, and artwork)

## **Responsibilities**

#### **Student Responsibilities:**

- Learn and abide by the Leesville Road High School Honor Code
- Pledge to uphold and sustain academic integrity by serving as an example to all students

- Help establish an academic environment where all members of the school community view cheating as socially unacceptable
- Understand that violations may prevent entry into the National Honor Society or other school honor societies

#### Parent/Guardian Responsibilities:

- Fully understand and support academic integrity and the Leesville Road High School Honor Code Policy
- Support the academic integrity of the school by establishing clear expectations with their student
- Support the school's decision regarding consequences should their student violate the Leesville Road High School Honor Code (see consequences below)

#### **Teacher Responsibilities:**

- To display, review, and uphold the Leesville Road High School Honor Code in the classroom
- To provide students specific examples of how this policy applies in their classes
- To keep a signed list of students' signatures signifying their understanding of the Honor Code for each class
- To closely monitor students in any academic setting
- To report any violation of the Leesville Road High School Honor Code to the parent/guardian and the appropriate administrator

#### Administrator Responsibilities:

- To provide students, parents, and faculty/staff with a written copy of the Leesville Road High School Honor Code
- To display the Leesville Road High School Honor Code in general areas of the school
- To review and uphold the Leesville Road High School Honor Code
- To meet with students referred for academic integrity violations and contact parents accordingly

## Consequences for Violating the Leesville Road High School Honor Code

#### 59 Rule

Any student caught cheating on any assignment will be able to re-do an alternate assignment, with the highest possible grade being a 59. Assignments that are not resubmitted within the designated period set by the teacher will be assigned a grade of 0. Additionally, the appropriate administrative consequence will be issued to the student.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Offense

- Parent contact (teacher and administrator) and 2 days of ISS
- Alternate assignment: 59 Rule

# 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense

- Parent contact (teacher and administrator) and 3 days of ISS
- Alternate assignment: 59 Rule

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense

- Parent contact (teacher and administrator) and 5 days of ISS
- Parent conference strongly encouraged if not held previously
- Alternate assignment: 59 Rule
