AP Exam Registration Information and Deadlines
For Virtual Academy Students Enrolled in First Semester and Year-long Classes

The 2022 AP Exams will be administered in school as paper and pencil exams during the first two weeks of May: May 2 – 6 and May 9 – 13. AP students will log into their CollegeBoard accounts to access AP exam information and material for their AP courses. Please follow these directions to set up or retrieve your account with CollegeBoard and access AP exam information and course material for your 1st semester and year-long AP courses:

Action Items for Students:

- Go to myap.collegeboard.org.
 - o If you already have established a CollegeBoard account, make certain that you can log in.
 - o If you have forgotten your password, you may call 888-225- 5427 or click “Forgot Password.”

- Virtual Academy students are taking first semester and year-long AP courses: (1) via NCVPS, or (2) with an Athens teacher, or (3) with a WCPSS (Non-Athens) teacher. Below are the instructions you need to follow to join your AP course in CollegeBoard and order an AP exam. Please read the instructions carefully since they vary depending on the course format and teacher.

o AP Course through NCVPS

1. Ask your AP teacher for the join code specific to your class section, and “join” the course to access CollegeBoard resources and practice opportunities.
2. Ms. Boothe will send you an “exam-only” join code to your WCPSS student email account in October. **You must use this join code to “join” the exam only section by November 5, 2021, to have an AP exam ordered for you.** IMPORTANT NOTE: If you “join” your AP teacher’s section but do not “join” the exam-only section, an AP exam **will not** be ordered for you.
3. If you do not desire to take the AP exam, please complete this [form](#) by **November 5, 2021**.

o AP Course with Athens Teacher

1. AP teachers will provide students with a join code specific to their class and period.
2. Follow prompts in your CollegeBoard account to join courses by November 5, 2021. **Students will automatically be registered to take the AP exam for each course they “join.”**
3. If you do not desire to take the AP exam, please complete this [form](#) by **November 5th, 2021**. **The CollegeBoard unused/cancelled exam fee for this school year is \$40.** Students who do not complete the Google form (above) by November 5th and do not take the AP exam for a 1st semester class will be responsible for paying the \$40 fee.

o AP Course with WCPSS (Non-Athens) Teacher

1. Ask your AP teacher for the join code specific to your class section, and “join” the course to access CollegeBoard resources and practice opportunities.
2. Ms. Boothe will send you an “exam-only” join code to your WCPSS student email account in October. **You must use this join code to “join” the exam only section by November 5th, 2021, to have an AP exam ordered for you.** IMPORTANT NOTE: If you “join” your AP teacher’s section but do not “join” the exam-only section, an AP exam will not be ordered for you.
3. If you do not desire to take the AP exam, please complete this [form](#) by **November 5th, 2021**.

*Joining a class will allow students access to a set of resources designed to provide them with practice opportunities and feedback throughout the year. **Students in AP courses 2nd semester will repeat this process at the beginning of 2nd semester.***

Fees

What is the cost for AP exams?

- **\$0** for students enrolled in the AP course during the 2021-2022 school year.
- **\$96** for Self-Study students (students not enrolled in the AP course during the 2021-2022 school year). We will provide additional information to self-study students in October.

What are the other fees associated with AP exams?

- Students who do not “join” their 1st semester or year-long AP course by the November 5th deadline may be required to pay a \$40 late fee, and in some cases, may not be able to order an AP exam for that course for the 2021-2022 school year. As a reminder, students who are not taught by an Athens teacher **must** join the exam-only section using the join code provided by Ms. Boothe by November 5th to have an exam ordered for them.

Additional Information

- Testing Accommodations

- If you need to request testing accommodations, you must apply to the CollegeBoard directly. Applications take about 6 – 8 weeks to process.
- Accommodations determined by the school do not apply to CollegeBoard tests.
- The deadline to apply for accommodations is **January 18, 2022**. If students have additional questions about CollegeBoard accommodations, please contact Jasmine Pearson, at jnpearson@wcpss.net

- Exam Schedule Conflicts

- If a student has two exams at the same time, one of the exams will be taken in a late testing session. Students will receive notice from Student Services about the test, time, and location closer to the exam administration.
