Special Notes

- Final Exams count 20% of a student's final grade. If a student does not take the Final Exam, their teacher will enter a "0" for the Final Exam grade when calculating the student's final grade.
- All End-Of-Course (EOC) and CTE Post Assessment Final Exams MUST be taken on the student's assigned WCPSS Chromebook.
- All Final Exams must be taken on campus.
- Bus transportation will be provided to students during Exam week. Buses will follow their normal schedule in the morning and then will depart Athens Drive at 12:00 p.m.
- Breakfast and Lunch will be available for students who must be on campus to take Exams.
- Students who do not have a Final Exam do not report to school on June 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, and 9th.
- Senior Exam Exemptions: Seniors who have a final grade of "C" or better in a course that does not require a State mandated Final Exam will be considered EXEMPT from the Final Exam from that course. Attendance will not count toward Senior Exam Exemptions for this school year. The Final Grade for the Senior for a course they are EXEMPT from taking a Final Exam will be calculated by counting Third Quarter Grade as 50% and Fourth Quarter Grade as 50%.
- Students are expected to take Exams at the scheduled times. Students must be present at the beginning of the Exam period to take the Exam and must remain for the entire Exam period to receive credit for the Exam. To maintain the integrity of all Exams, students will not be permitted to check-out early during an Exam period.
- If absent from an Exam, the student is responsible for working with the teacher to schedule the make-up Exam for a Teacher-Made Exam. For a State Exam (an EOC or a CTE Post Assessment), our Testing Coordinator will schedule the make-up State Exam on Friday, June 9th.

According to North Carolina Testing Policy, electronic devices (other than approved calculators and the student's assigned WCPSS Chromebook) are not permitted in the testing room at any time during State Testing, including breaks. Any student with a cell phone/electronic device during the testing period may be dismissed from testing, and a misadministration may be declared for that student. A student who has been dismissed for a violation of the electronic device policy must take the missed Final Exam on the Make-Up Day. Per WCPSS Board Policy 3225, the student is subject to disciplinary action by administration.
