# GRADUATION HANDBOOK

#### SPECIAL NOTES TO THE GRADUATING CLASS

- 1. Extra tassels will be available at a cost of \$10. Should you lose your tassel, you will be required to purchase another. ONLY ORANGE TASSELS ARE TO BE WORN AT GRADUATION!
- 2. Be prepared at all times to pay for parking at the Raleigh Convention Center! Minimum of \$10 (some of the parking decks rates are per hour)!
- 3. A professional photographer will be available to take the pictures of Seniors as they receive their diplomas. Seniors will receive information concerning picture ordering information at the Graduation Rehearsal on May 25. Evan Pike Photography offers a convenient online portal so you can preview before you order. More details coming on May 25!
- 4. Please tell your parents/friends/family NOT to bring any of the following items to Graduation: POSTERS, BALLOONS, FLOWERS (in glass vases), or WRAPPED PACKAGES! None of theses items can be brought into the Raleigh Convention Center! If they bring it, it will be taken and thrown away!
- 5. Confirmation of grades and Graduation status will be made by noon (12:00pm) of the school day on June 9<sup>th</sup> and the Counselors will notify those NOT Graduating Friday afternoon on June 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. Tickets for Graduation
  - a. Each Senior will be issued 7 tickets (at the Graduation Rehearsal) for admission to commencement exercises. We are waiting for guidance from WCPSS to see if we can offer extra tickets. If we are able, then you will receive those at Rehearsal on May 25. If you need additional tickets it is up to each Senior to find extra tickets from other Seniors.
  - b. One (1) ticket will be needed for each person, **INCLUDING INFANTS** and **CHILDREN**, who attends commencement. **NO ONE** without a ticket will be admitted to the commencement exercise.
  - c. Tickets will be distributed to Seniors at the conclusion of Graduation rehearsal. Each Senior is responsible for getting his/her own tickets. **IF YOU ARE NOT PRESENT AT REHEARSAL YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE TICKETS.**
  - d. Any Senior who has not paid his/her graduation fee and other school debts will **NOT** be issued tickets.
  - e. Fees/ Fines will *need to be paid at school* before tickets can be issued!
  - f. **EXTRA TICKET REQUEST FORM** is at the back of this packet, assuming we get the approval to issue extra tickets!

#### **GRADUATION REHEARSAL-NO GRADUATING SENIOR CAN MISS THIS PRACTICE!**

#### Thursday, May 25, 2023, Athens Drive Upper Gym @ 7:25AM

\*7:00am.- Advisors, marshals, and all students who have a part in the program report to the Upper Gym.

#### \*7:15am- Senior Class reports to the Upper Gym.

- If an emergency arises that should cause you to miss practice, you are to call the attendance office at Athens (919-233-4050, ext. 24881) give your name and nature of emergency.
- Caps and gowns should be worn.
- Names will be placed in the seats in the alphabetical order that seniors are to be presented for diplomas.
- Seniors should find their assigned seats and SIT DOWN to wait for instructions from advisors.
- The class advisors and administrators will give instructions, Seniors will then practice until the procedure is clear and correct. <u>Full cooperation on the part of everyone will make the rehearsal</u> shorter.
- Seniors participating in the program (class officers and platform speakers) will march in front of the class. Upon reaching the stage, they will take their seats on the platform.
- After the graduation program is over, Junior Marshals will escort those on stage off. Then the class leaves in the recessional.
- Seniors will rehearse the processional, recessional, getting on and off stage, and standing and sitting as a class.
- The rehearsal will be dismissed ONLY when faculty advisors feel that there has been sufficient practice to ensure an orderly graduation!

#### **GRADUATION**

#### SATURDAY, JUNE 10, 2023-12:00pm -RALEIGH CONVENTION CENTER

- \*Seniors will report in proper attire at <u>11:00am SHARP</u> and find their seat in the staging area.
- \*Seniors should allow themselves plenty of time to have cars parked and be in their position by 11:15am.

### \*EVERYONE MUST BE PRESENT BY 11:15am -DIPLOMAS FOR THOSE ABSENT WILL BE REMOVED FROM STAGE AT THIS TIME!

- \*Procedure will be exactly the same as rehearsed in the practice.
- \*It is of utmost importance that all Seniors follow the directions of the Junior Marshals/Drive-Time teachers/advisors at all times. Their directions must be followed without question or argument.
- \*Final instructions will be given and the class will be escorted out to wait in line for the processional.
- \*During the ceremony, a professional photographer will take pictures of those receiving their diplomas. NO ONE ELSE WILL BE PERMITTED TO TAKE PICTURES ON THE FLOOR OF THE RALEIGH CONVENTION CENTER WHILE THE CEREMONY IS IN PROGRESS!
- \*Seniors are reminded that this is a dignified ceremony and their behavior MUST reflect this dignity.
- \*Please silence ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES!

REMEMBER: WE ARE THE <u>ONLY</u> SCHOOL IN WAKE COUNTY THAT GIVES THE DIPLOMA TO THE GRADUATE WHEN THEY WALK ACROSS STAGE! IF YOU BEHAVE INAPPROPRIATELY AT ANYTIME-

YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE YOUR DIPLOMA AND INSTEAD YOU WILL GET
INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO CALL MR. MARES TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT TO GET
YOUR DIPLOMA IN HIS OFFICE AND DISCUSS YOUR BEHAVIOR AT GRADUATION.

#### ATTIRE FOR GRADUATES DURING GRADUATION

#### **WOMEN**

- 1. Simple, lightweight dress under Graduation robes (Not to exceed length of gown) OR dress pants.
- 2. Shoes should be classy and comfortable for walking! "Peep-toe" shoes okay. (No TENNIS SHOES or FLIP FLOPS!)
- 3. Minimal Jewelry. No jewelry on outside of Cap & Gown! (NO LARGE EARRINGS!)
- 4. Hairstyle which will fit under Graduation cap.

#### **MEN**

- 1. White/light colored dress shirt, and dark tie. (bow ties can be worn, just look classy! NO BRIGHT COLORS!)
- 2. Dress pants dark blue, gray, black, tan, (NO JEANS, CARGOS, SWEATPANTS, SHORTS, etc)
- 3. Dress shoes (NO deck shoes Tennis Shoes, topsiders, flip flops OR Boots!)
- 4. Suit coats may be worn, but are probably going to be hot!
- 5. ALL SENIORS male and female should bring extra safety pins and hairpins.

#### **CONDUCT**

- 1. We want this to be a happy time for you, but we also want it to be a dignified ceremony.
- 2. No cat calling, yelling, or any pranks during any part of the ceremony.
- 3. NO TALKING during processional or recessional!!
- 4. All school rules apply to all graduation activities.
- 5. NO GUM NO SMOKING NO VAPING while in cap and gown.
- 6. Students not on time to line-up, rehearsals, etc., will NOT go through the ceremony.
- 7. IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO ABIDE BY THE RULES, DO NOT EXPECT TO RECEIVE YOUR DIPLOMA WITH THE REST OF THE SENIOR CLASS OR PARTICIPATE IN THE CEREMONY.

#### YOU CANNOT DECORATE THE TOP OF YOUR GRADUATION CAP!

#### **GRADUATION ETIQUETTE**


- 1. Cap & Gowns should always be worn in a dignified way. Be sure the gowns are neatly pressed. WARNING: USE A COOL IRON AS THE GOWNS WILL MELT! (One suggestion often made is to hang the gown up in a bathroom and to let the warm air from the shower slowly pull out the wrinkles.)
- 2. Caps are always worn straight on the head, parallel to the floor, by both men and women. (This will be adjusted as needed before you enter the Graduation area on the main floor.) **DO NOT DECORATE YOUR CAP! NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- 3. The tassel is always worn over the <u>right</u> temple. The tassel will be turned at the conclusion of the ceremony to show your new status as a Graduate.
- 4. When the National Anthem and Pledge of Allegiance are performed, everyone should stand. Men will remove their caps and place them under their left arms.
- 5. Seniors will graduate in alphabetical order. Upon hearing his/her name called, each senior will walk across the stage with your eyes on the principal to receive your diploma.
- 6. The diploma is received with the left hand. The principal's hand is extended to shake with the student's right hand. (LEFT HAND OVER RIGHT HAND)
- 7. As the diplomas are presented, a professional photographer will take your picture.

  \*\*ABSOLUTELY NO OTHER PERSON WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PICTURES FROM THE FLOOR OF THE CONVENTION CENTER!\*\*
- 8. After receiving your diploma, proceed across the stage and down the stairs and return to your seat. Follow directions of the Junior Marshals who are there to assist you. Seniors who are seated on the stage will turn right and return to their seats on stage.
- 9. During the recessional, it is imperative that all graduates follow the marshals and keep moving out to exit the Convention Center at the street level. Please tell your family and friends that you will meet them at the street level as you will NOT BE ALLOWED TO RE-ENTER THE CONVENTION CENTER ONCE YOU LEAVE.









## NOTES ABOUT ENTRY & EXIT FROM THE CONVENTION CENTER

- 1. Entry into the convention center can be made at numerous locations NO SOONER THAN 60 MINUTES BEFORE COMMENCEMENT, however once in the building access to the convention floor is restricted.
- 2. Graduates will need to use  $\underline{entry\ point\ C}$  to access the convention floor where the Graduate Assembly Area is.
- 3. Parents/Family/Friends will need to use  $\underbrace{\textit{entry point } A}$  to access the convention floor where the General Seating Area is.
- 4. Handicapped guests will need to use  $\underbrace{\textit{entry point }B}$  to access the convention floor where the Handicap Seating Area is.
- 5. Once the Commencement has begun, please refrain from movement so as to limit distractions during the ceremony.
- 6. At the conclusion of the Commencement, please exit the convention floor the same way you entered. YOU WILL BE PERMITTED TO GO BEHIND THE STAGE TO MEET YOUR GRADUATE, HOWEVER PLEASE MEET THEM AND EXIT!
- 7. Please keep in mind that there will be a LARGE crowd trying to exit the floor of the Convention Center after Graduation, so BE PATIENT! Please move up the escalators/elevator quickly and DO NOT STOP AT THE TOP!
