The Athens Drive MHS Exam Exemption Policy reads as follows:

Exam Exemption POLICY:

Seniors may be exempt from exams based on the following criteria:

- Students must have a final grade of B or higher
- Students must have 10 or fewer absences in the course.
- Students cannot be exempt from state testing including field testing.

Exam exemption is determined on a course-by-course basis, meaning one course grade does not affect another.

To provide some clarification to the guidelines above:

- Absences will all count equally when considering eligibility for exam exemptions. Absences may be *excused* or *unexcused*.
- College visitations will count as part of the 10 days.
- Juniors (in Grade 11) who are Graduating early ARE ELIGIBLE FOR EXAM EXEMPTIONS.

All schools will provide notice to students regarding eligibility for senior exam exemptions at the beginning of the school year. Details related to the exam exemption process (noted above) will be added to the 2025-2026 High School Program Planning Guide. In the absence of any specific policy language, the Program Planning Guide often serves as the source of guidance and information for schools on a variety of topics, including exam exemptions.
