2018-2019 DATA (Most recent data because of covid-19)

- **Exceeded** student academic growth expectations overall.
- Exceeded student growth expectations in math. Second highest growth in math in WCPSS.
- **Met or exceeded** student academic growth expectations for **all** measured subgroups, including Academically or Intellectually Gifted (AIG), Asian, black, economically disadvantaged, English learners, Hispanic, students with disabilities (SWD), and white.
- **Surpassed** NC long-term goal for English learner progress by 15%.
- **62%** of teachers in grades 3-5 were recognized for being in the top 25% of teachers in the district and/or state based on student growth in reading and/or math.
- **5** National Board Certified Teachers . . . and more starting the process.
- All teachers are certified and highly qualified.

- 91% of families responded that Salem is welcoming to parents.
- **89%** of families responded that Salem provides appropriate information about family involvement opportunities.
