W How to Apply

1. Apply Online

Visit the Students tab on the PCHS website and click "2025–2026 Student Parking." You can also <u>Click Here.</u>

- 2. Upload Required Documents
 - Valid NC Driver License (No learner's permits)
 - Vehicle registration(s) up to 2 vehicles
 - Clear photos or scans accepted (try to combine both in one image)
 - The address on your driver license must match Infinite Campus.
 - Temporary paper licenses from the DMV are accepted if they include your name and address.
- 3. Complete the Parking Safety Course on Canvas when you receive a Canvas invitation.
 - © Score 90% or higher to receive your parking tag.
- 4. Pay the \$200 Fee
 - Once your application is approved, you'll receive instructions for payment.(No payments are accepted until your application is reviewed.)

Parking Tags & Assigned Spaces

- Tags issued after course completion and fee payment.
- Parking spaces are assigned as applications are approved.
- Tags must be hung from the rearview mirror at all times on campus.
- Students may share a space (both must apply, only one pays). Each can register up to 2 cars.

Z Parking Waitlist

- If all spots are filled, online registration will close.
- Submit a paper waitlist application to the front office.
- Spots are assigned by submission date, but Early Release or other needs may take

- i Key Regulations & Reminders
- Only 1 tag per space. Shareable, but not transferable.
- Must park in assigned space—no back-in parking allowed.
- Speed limit: 10 MPH. Seat belts required.
- No loud music or loitering in the lot.
- Parking only allowed in student lots (not driveways, roads, or staff areas).
- $\bullet \;\;$ Vehicles may be searched under WCPSS policy.
- Students with Early Release must leave campus on time.
- Excessive tardiness may result in revoked parking privileges.
- Lost tags = \$10 replacement fee.
- Any vehicle changes must be reported to the front office.

Refunds are given only if a student withdraws from WCPSS.
