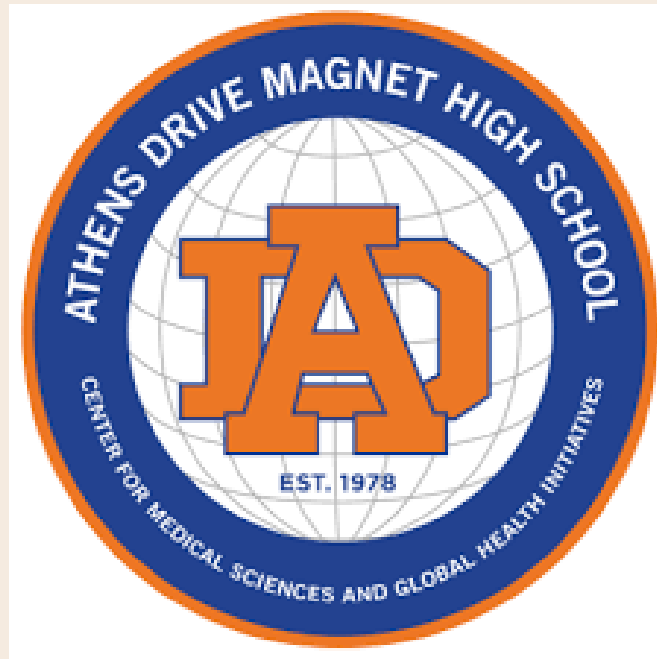

6 Electives*

***2 MUST be courses in CTE, Arts or World Language**

4 English

4 Math

3 Science

4 Social Studies

1 Healthful Living

PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS

22 High School credits are needed to graduate

9th > 10th

English I; two credits in the areas of Math, Social Studies, or Science; and three additional credits, for 6 total

High School students are promoted according to the number of credits earned

10th > 11th

English II; one credit in Math, Social Studies; one credit in Science; and two additional credits for 12 total

No social promotion

11th > 12th

English III; enrollment in a program which if successfully accomplished, will result in the completion of graduation requirements ; 18 total credits



HIGH SCHOOL COURSES IN MIDDLE SCHOOL

Some courses you take in middle school **do**
count for credit in high school

Grade **will not** be a part of the high school GPA

Grade **will** appear on the transcript and earn
credit toward graduation

Check with your Counselor about credit!

GPA AND QUALITY POINTS

A grade point average (GPA) is a calculated average of the final grades you earn in school following a 4.0 scale

Quality points are the cumulative points used to calculate GPA

Classes earn quality points based on their rigor

Every semester, you'll receive a cumulative GPA based on the grades you earned in your classes

Grade	Standard	Honors	AP/IB
A	4	4.5	5

COURSE REGISTRATION

Registration is your time to request which courses you would like to take.

Students will choose **8 primary courses & 3-4 alternates**

Choosing Alternate courses is just as important as choosing primary courses; Students may receive alternate courses. Do not choose the same courses for primary and alternates

Students may have up to three core courses in one semester

Course registration is not the same as enrollment!!

COURSE REGISTRATION

- Use your guide to help choose electives
- Do not double up on core classes (ex: English 1 and 2)
- Some paired courses will take up a core spot and an elective spot
 - ex: Foundations of Math 1 & Math 1B
 - Honors Math Plus & Math 2
 - Honors 21st Century Geography & AP World
