WAKE BYOD WIFI

2. With WIFI enabled, enter **WAKE-BYOD** when prompted for a new network name (SSID). The name will not be broadcasted, you will have to manually type it in under the Network Name.
3. There is no password, but be sure to capitalize **WAKE-BYOD**.

AMS BYOD Contract

Student Expectations

- Students **MUST** have permission to bring a device to school
- Students **AND** guardians are required to sign the BYOD contract
- **ONLY** the owner of the device can touch...not a friend or a teacher
- Device for instructional purposes only
- AMS is not responsible for providing facilities to charge devices; devices are expected to be charged at home and put away after the battery loses its charge
- **NO DEVICE USE ZONES:** Bathrooms and Locker Rooms
- School Staff reserves the right to change procedures and storage of devices as needed



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Frequently Asked Questions

What Devices Can Be Used in AMS BYOD?

Apex Middle School defines “devices” as privately owned wireless and portable electronic devices that can be used for wireless Internet access, word processing, image/video capturing, sound recording, and information transmitting.

What is the Purpose of BYOD?

AMS BYOD is available to students to support learning, enhance instruction, and provide the best possible outcome for student learning.

Who Decides When Students Use BYOD?

BYOD will be used for instructional purposes only. Teachers will communicate to students when BYOD is appropriate.

Can Students Share Devices?

Students understand they are prohibited from using any student’s device other than their own. It is clearly written in the contract that students are responsible for their own device(s).

How Do Students Sign Up for BYOD?

Students and parents will sign the AMS BYOD contract and return to their homeroom teacher.

What Happens if Students Misuse Their Device?

BYOD is a privilege. There will be consequences if you are not following proper BYOD classroom procedures.

STUDENT DEVICE EXPECTATIONS

- ▶ Students *MUST* have permission
- ▶ Students *AND* guardians are required to sign the BYOD contract
- ▶ *ONLY* the owner of the device can use
- ▶ Device for instructional purposes only
- ▶ AMS is not responsible for providing facilities to charge devices
- ▶ Devices are prohibited in bathrooms and locker rooms
- ▶ School Staff reserves the right to alter procedures

CLASSROOM AND DISCIPLINE

- ▶ Only use device when teacher allows
- ▶ Snapchat, Vine, Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram are prohibited
- ▶ Device must be on BYOD Wi-Fi
- ▶ Pictures/Videos/Audio recordings will only be allowed with teacher permission
- ▶ Only your student email is allowed

- ▶ If BYOD rules are not met...
 - ▶ 1st offense: verbal warning
 - ▶ 2nd offense: Device will be put away
 - ▶ 3rd offense: Refer to administration

SECURITY

- ▶ It is the student's responsibility to keep up with their own device
- ▶ When the device is not in use, it should be secured and put away
- ▶ Do not ask someone to hold your device
- ▶ WCPSS, AMS, teachers, and principals, are not responsible for lost/stolen/or damaged devices
