College Application Checklist

- 1. Need to <u>research</u> more schools? Use CFNC's College Search <u>page</u> for schools within NC or College Board's <u>search tool</u> to include schools outside of NC too.
- 2. Have a list of schools you want to <u>apply</u> to? Choose the best application platform for you:
 - a. Common App: <u>https://www.commonapp.org/</u>
 - b. CFNC.org: <u>https://www.cfnc.org/apply-to-college/</u>
 - c. Some schools may require you to use their own website*
- 3. Need <u>In-State Tuition</u>? Be sure to complete the RDS process <u>here</u>.
 - a. Hint: you only need 1 account for <u>RDS</u> and applications through CFNC
 - b. You must complete this process and include the number you get at the end on your applications to receive in state tuition
- 4. Need Financial Aid? Be sure to complete the <u>FAFSA</u> process here: <u>https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</u>

a. ALL students should complete a FAFSA application (Opens 10/1)

- 5. Helpful Information for <u>Common App</u>
 - a. You must add your counselor to your list of recommenders so they can send your transcript for you.

 - c. Essay: You must choose only 7 of the 6 prompts and make sure that your response answers the prompt completely in 250-650 words
- 6. <u>Transcripts</u> -If you're applying through Common App counselors will send a transcript on your behalf once you add them as a recommender- but please also send your transcript, if in state, <u>through CFNC as well</u>. If you're applying only through CFNC, you can and should request a transcript through their Application Hub. If you need a transcript for a scholarship, pay close attention to their requirements and email your counselor with any questions/needs.
