Wake Tech Application Checklist

- Create an account with <u>cfnc.org</u>. Various steps are housed through their website. Make sure to save your username and password for your reference.
- 2. Visit the WTCC admissions page for more information: https://www.waketech.edu/admissions
 - a. You can find contact information or make arrangements to meet with a recruiter if needed.
- 3. Complete the <u>Residency Determination</u> process at <u>https://ncresidency.cfnc.org/residencyInfo/</u>
 - a. Use your CFNC login information to access the site
 - b. Consider completing this step with a parent. You will need social security numbers and more to complete this.
 - c. Be sure that each step is completed accurately before submitting. You will <u>not</u> be able to edit after you complete each section. If you have any trouble, contact RDS at 844-319-3640 (Hours are Mon Thurs 8am-6pm, Friday 8am-5pm)
 - d. Once this is complete you will have an RCN number to show that you are eligible for in-state tuition.
- 4. Apply to Wake Tech here: https://apply.cfnc.org/application/WakeTCC/Undergrad/WakeTCCApp
 - a. You can save and complete your application in multiple sittings if needed.
 - b. You can always return to your application in the CFNC Application Hub here: https://www2.cfnc.org/apphub
- 5. Send a <u>transcript</u> to WTCC, through the CFNC Application Hub.
 - a. On the right side of the page you will find Request a Transcript
 - b. Verify your information is correct and be sure to enter your name EXACTLY as it appears on PowerSchool
 - c. Save your personal information, scroll down and select Wake Tech, and request your transcript
 - d. You can check the status of your request in the Application Hub by clicking on "Show Tasks" under your application
- 6. Apply for financial aid through <u>FAFSA</u>: https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa
 - a. You first need an FSA ID -be sure to save this information, you will need it every year
 - b. The FAFSA application opens on 10/1 -the sooner you submit your application the better your chances are of receiving additional financial aid
 - c. Consider completing this process with a parent. You will need a lot of personal information, including tax documentation.
 - d. Don't hesitate to ask for support if you have questions about this process. You have resources available through CFNC, FAFSA, WTCC, and our financial aid advisor Ms. Winters.
- 7. Check your email and follow admissions steps from WTCC.
