Effective Wednesday, March 7, the student parking lot entrance will be only for students and staff from 6:45 am to 7:30 am. No one will be able to exit the student parking lot until after 7:30 am. Anyone dropping students off should always use carpool.

Parents, when dropping your child off in carpool only allow them to exit the car under the overhang. Students getting out of the car early creates major safety issues especially when students get out of the car early and are walking in front of other cars. Parents should not pull into parking spaces to drop students off as well. Several near accidents have happened as a result of this practice.
