PSAT Registration Deadline upcoming | The Wake County Public School System will offer the PSAT on Wednesday, Oct. 10th.

The PSAT is a standardized, multiple-choice test that includes three sections: critical reading, mathematics and writing. The test provides practice for the SAT and offers insight for advising and counseling students.

Students must register by September 10, 2018 to be allowed to take the PSAT. Your child may register at school in Student Services. To register, there is an administration fee of \$16 that must be paid.

The PSAT allows 11th grade students the opportunity to potentially qualify for a National Merit scholarship if they receive a very high score (generally the top 1%). For this reason, WCPSS is offering the test free of charge to those students with a weighted GPA of 4.313 or higher. Fee waivers are also available for students based on financial need.
