Reminders from August 8, 2022 Newsletter

Early Release Days 22-23

In 2021, the NC General Assembly passed a law requiring elementary teachers to complete the LETRS (Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling) Professional Learning. The Professional Learning consists of 8 units with each unit requiring up to 8 hours of asynchronous work before a full day of live training. To provide some time for teachers to complete this asynchronous work, the WCPSS Board of Education designated six early release days during the 22-23 school year (Sept. 2, Nov. 10, Dec. 5, Dec. 21, Mar. 24, & May 9). These days will be a 2- hour early release (1:45 pm dismissal).

Friday, Sept. 2, 2022 is our first Early Release Day!

Breakfast/Lunch Information

- Pre-Pay for Meals Online: www.MySchoolBucks.com or call (855) 832-5226 to enroll. You'll need your child's NCWISE ID number, available in your registration materials or at your school. Once your account is established you may:
 - Securely deposit funds to your child's account
 - Check balances
 - Set spending limits
- During the 22-23 school year, meals are not free for students as they were during the past two years. In the event that a student is unable to pay for a meal on a particular day, the student may charge a reimbursable meal so long as it does not create a negative account balance that exceeds the value of three (3) days of meals (breakfast and lunch) based on current student meal prices. If a student is unable to pay for or charge a meal, the student will be served a designated alternate meal (fruits and vegetables) which will be provided at no cost to the student.

Late Check-in/Early Check-out

We are implementing a new check-in/check-out system this year. When your student is late or when you need to check your student out early, please scan the QR code posted in front of the main doors. The QR code will lead you to a brief form to complete.

- 1. Using your smartphone, scan the QR code
- 2. Complete the form
- 3. Ring the intercom bell
- 4. Ms. Burnet will assist you

Just a reminder....when visiting the school, our front desk receptionist, Mrs. Burnet, will routinely engage with you through the speaker before buzzing you into the building. Additionally, she will regularly check IDs when signing your child out early.

Volunteer Registration 22-23

Volunteers are visitors who may or may not be alone with students at any point. Volunteers do require background checks. There are no "levels" of volunteer status. Typical examples range from a community volunteer who reads with a child to an overnight chaperone, as well as field day workers, testing proctors, field trip chaperone and volunteer coaches. The same background check is done for every type of volunteer.

- Current volunteers, who were approved for the 2021-22 school year, do not have to register again this year.
- New Volunteers for 2022-23
 - O All new volunteer applicants must register and have an approved criminal record check prior to engaging in volunteer work. New volunteer applicants may go to any WCPSS work site and register through wcpss.net by selecting the Community tab, and then selecting Volunteer. Applicants will be notified by email once their application has been approved. Applicants who are not approved will receive notice from Employee Relations.

Here Comes the Bus

WCPSS Transportation provides families of students who ride a yellow bus to school with a free bus tracking system called **Here Comes the Bus**. **Here Comes the Bus** translates GPS data into an easy-to-use customizable map that works on a computer, tablet, or smartphone. The app allows you to see where the bus is and how close it is to your stop.

Get started with **Here Comes the Bus** at https://herecomesthebus.com/parents/get-started/. You will need the district code and your student's ID number to sign up. For your smartphone or tablet, download the **Here Comes the Bus** app from the App Store or Google Play.

The WCPSS school code for Yellow Bus is **67500**. The WCPSS school code for Vendor Transportation Services is **67501**. <u>Learn more about Here Comes the Bus for Vendor Transportation Services</u>.

When entering your student's last name on the app, spell it as it appears on your Home Base/PowerSchool account. If there is a hyphen in the name, make sure you include it. Only enter the first 18 characters of your student's last name. If your name is, *Yellow-School Bus Wake*, you will enter *Yellow-School Bus* in the last name field.
