Kindergarten Registration for 2018-2019

Families who have students currently enrolled at MPE in grades 1st through 4th and have a rising kindergarten student for the 2018-2019 school year, it is imperative that you register your student before April 1, 2018. This will ensure sibling priority and a guaranteed seat for your rising kindergarten student.

Single Subject Acceleration – Nomination Window

Single Subject Acceleration (SSA) in the Wake County Public School System is a practice through which students meeting qualifying criteria in grades K-7 can take advanced academic content in Mathematics or English/Language Arts (ELA). SSA is an accelerative practice that allows students to show mastery of content of an elementary or middle school course without having taken the course. Parents may nominate their child to skip a grade level of content in either English Language Arts or Mathematics. Nominated students will be assessed at school. Depending on grade level and subject, this could include a multiple-choice test and/or a writing sample.

• The SSA Nomination Window is April 13, 2018 through April 26, 2018 (3:45 pm). No late SSA Nominations will be accepted.
