### **Parent-Student Welcome Letter 2025-2026**

During the week of Aug. 4th, I will send my 2025-2026 Parent-Student Welcome Letter via SchoolMessenger. It will also be posted on the school website. The letter will contain a lot of information that will help you and your student(s) start the new school year on a positive note.

### **Check Your Bus Transportation Status before June 30, 2025**

*View your student's 2025-26 Transportation status via your student's Homebase/Powerschool account before June 30, 2025, as we will move to a new program (Infinite Campus) that you will be given directions on how to access after July 1st.*

Your student's AM and/or PM transportation codes will display "Y" (yes) or "N" (no) for the 2025-26 school year until routes are posted. Routes usually are posted about 10 days before the start of the school year.

- If your student's code is "Y" and your student will be using transportation next school year, no action is required.
- If your student's code is "N" and you would like for your student to use transportation next school year, please submit a transportation request [here](#).

### **Request Bus Transportation for 2025-2026**

If you are not currently registered for transportation but would like service next school year, you **must** request transportation by **July 14, 2025** to ensure service on the first day. Please submit a transportation request [here](#).

**EOG Remediation with Readministration Opportunity – June 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>**

At the end of the school year, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, & 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will participate in the regular administration of North Carolina End-of-Grade (EOG) tests. Students who score Level 3 or higher on these assessments are considered proficient. Students who do not score a Level 3 or higher on the EOG and have passed the course/ subject during the school year will have the option to participate in a Remediation with Readministration opportunity. Our remediation with readministration opportunity will be held on June 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> for eligible students. Transportation will be provided, and breakfast and lunch will be available.
