Parent-Student Welcome Letter 2024-2025

During the week of Aug. 5th, I will send my 2024-2025 Parent-Student Welcome Letter via SchoolMessenger. It will also be posted on the school website. The letter will contain a lot of information that will help you and your student(s) start the new school year on a positive note.

Check Your Bus Transportation Status

View your student's 2024-25 Transportation status via your student's Homebase/Powerschool account. Sign up for an account at your student's school. More information on Home Base is available at www.wcpss.net/student-information.

Your student's AM and/or PM transportation codes will display "Y" (yes) or "N" (no) for the 2024-25 school year until routes are posted. Routes usually are posted about 10 days before the start of the school year.

- If your student's code is "Y" and your student will be using transportation next school year, no action is required.
- If your student's code is "N" and you would like for your student to use transportation next school year, please submit a transportation request.



Request Bus Transportation for 2024-2025

If you are not currently registered for transportation but would like service next school year, you **must** request transportation by **July 15, 2024** to ensure service on the first day.

Wake Pre-K Enrollment for the 2024-25 School Year:

Do you have a child who will be 4 years old by August 31st, 2024 and is a Wake County resident? If so, consider applying for Wake Pre-K through the Universal Application. The Wake Pre-K application allows consideration for free, safe, and fun Pre-K program options.

Participating programs include NC Pre-Kindergarten (NC Pre-K), WCPSS Title I, and Telamon Head Start. To learn more, visit the Wake Pre-K Application Center.

Enrollment into the Wake County Public School System Title I Pre-K program is based on the academic need of the child. NC Pre-K and Head Start are prioritized for families with low incomes and other related eligibility requirements. When your application is processed, your child will be considered for the program that best matches your family based on the criteria. Applications are not first come, first served. **The deadline to apply is June 16.**
