Late Arrival/Early Dismissal

Please remember to sign your child in/out on the yellow pad in front of the main doors if you are dropping your children off after 9:15 am or picking them up before 3:45 pm.

Early Arrival Program – Space Available

Mills Park's on-site Before-School Care program has room for more students. If your child is enrolled in the program, you may drop him/her off as early as 7:00 am (park along bus loop and walk student into the cafeteria). The cost per month for each child is \$94.65. There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$15.00 per child. You can enroll your child(ren) in Before School Care now by completing this Before School Care Registration form.

School Board Approves November 12, 2021 as Non-Instructional Day for Students

On October 19th, the Board of Education approved a change to the 2021-2022 school year calendar that extends the upcoming Veterans Day holiday break in November. The decision means that, in addition to the Veterans Day holiday on Thursday, Nov. 11, the following day of Friday, Nov. 12, will be used as a remote workday for all staff, and will be a non-instructional day for students.

Spelling Bee 2022

- Class Spelling Bees (grades 1-5) will be held the week of Jan. 3rd (the week we return from the holiday break)
- The School Spelling Bee is scheduled for January 14, 2022. Only class spelling bee winners from grades 3, 4, 5 participate in the School Spelling Bee.

Monthly Reminders

Isolation/Quarantine & Continuing Education

If a student attending school in-person must quarantine due to exposure to COVID or isolate due a positive test, your child's teacher will post assignments on their Google Classroom site. Parents will be contacted within three days on how to access the Google Classroom site and to provide any other pertinent information.

Students Experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms

Students must stay home if experiencing any of the following COVID-19 symptoms:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If a student is experiencing one of the COVID-19 symptoms listed above, he/she must meet 1 of 3 pathways to return after COVID-19 symptoms:

- negative PCR/Molecular COVID-19 test
- alternate diagnosis
- presumed positive
