Dear Parents.

During the first month of school, teachers and staff have done a wonderful job maintaining a strong focus on the well-being of the students and delivering quality instruction all the while juggling the many COVID procedures and protocols. The students have also done an incredible job of following all expectations and procedures. As we move forward, we will continue to add and modify procedures to ensure the safety of MPE students and staff. You will be updated of any changes in my monthly newsletter. For example, below is information about the recent changes we made regarding recess.

We will get on the other side of this! I continue to hope and pray that a vaccine will be available for our students in the very near future.

Update - Recess

Last week we implemented Recess Zones. During recess, students will play in a designated area with only the students from their class. This will help minimize spread if there is a positive case of COVID. It will also allow us to a better of job of contact tracing, if necessary, during recess time. Classes will play in a different Recess Zone each day.

Update - Isolation/Quarantine & Continuing Education

If a student attending school in-person must quarantine due to exposure to COVID or isolate due a positive test, your child's teacher will post assignments on their Google Classroom site. Parents will be contacted within three days on how to access the Google Classroom site and to provide any other pertinent information.

Changing Learning Environments

As I mentioned in last month's newsletter, registration in the WCPSS Virtual Academy is closed. I am also not able to move students from Virtual Academy to in-person learning at this time. If WCPSS decides to allow students to change learning environments, I will notify you immediately.

Students Experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms

Students must stay home if experiencing any of the following COVID-19 symptoms:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat.



- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If a student is experiencing one of the COVID-19 symptoms listed above, he/she must meet 1 of 3 pathways to return after COVID-19 symptoms:

- negative PCR/Molecular COVID-19 test
- alternate diagnosis
- presumed positive
