Here Comes the Bus

WCPSS Transportation provides bus rider families with a free bus tracking system called Here Comes the Bus.

Here Comes the Bus translates GPS data into an easy to use customizable map that works on a computer, tablet or smartphone. The app allows you to see where the bus is and how close it is to your stop.

Get started with *Here Comes the Bus* at <u>https://herecomesthebus.com/getting-started/</u>. You will need the district code and your student's ID number to sign up. The **WCPSS school code is 67500**. For your smartphone or tablet, download the *Here Comes the Bus* app from the <u>App Store</u> or <u>Google Play</u>.

When entering your student's last name on the app, spell it as it appears on your Home Base/PowerSchool account. If there is a hyphen in the name, make sure you include it. Only enter the first 18 characters of your student's last name. Once activated, you can customize or edit features, including how the app will communicate with you and the size of the notification radius.



Volunteer Reactivation and Registration

I would like to remind continuing volunteers, approved during the 2017-2018 school year, to reactivate your status as a volunteer <u>no later than 4:00 p.m. on November 15, 2018</u>. Volunteers may go to any WCPSS site and register through the WCPSS internet site (<u>www.wcpss.net</u>) and clicking on the *Community* Tab and then *Volunteer Registration*. After November 15, 2018, individuals previously approved may not volunteer without a new criminal record check. To avoid unnecessary costs to the school system, please remember to reactivate early in the school year – and no later than November 15, 2018.

New volunteer applicants for the 2018-2019 school year must register and have an approved criminal record check prior to engaging in volunteer work. Volunteers may go to any WCPSS site and register through the WCPSS internet site (<u>www.wcpss.net</u>) and clicking on the *Community* Tab and then *Volunteer Registration*.
