Dear Mills Park Families,

Welcome to Mills Park Elementary for the 2019-2020 school year! I hope this letter finds you well rested and excited to start a new school year. We are so excited to get started! The purpose of this letter is to provide you with important information and dates that will help you start the year on a positive note.

Class Lists

This year, we decided to do things a little differently with class lists. Class lists have already been completed. Teachers will mail postcards to students on August 14th welcoming them to their class.

Meet the Teacher

We have also made a change to Meet-the-Teacher Day. This year, we will host one session for grades 1-5 on Thursday, August 22^{nd} from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm. This is a drop-in time, so please come anytime during these two hours.

Master Schedule

We've made a major change to our master schedule. Our school-wide Common Math Time has been moved to the last period of the day (2:35-3:35). Obviously, this is a critically important instructional block. Please understand that early checkouts will impact your child's participation in math instruction.

New Front Desk Receptionist

I'm excited to announce that Joan Burnet is our new front desk receptionist. Cindi Warren has moved into the data manager position. Being new to Mills Park, Mrs. Burnett will routinely engage with you through the speaker before buzzing you into the building. Additionally, she will regularly check IDs when checking your child out early. I appreciate your patience as Mrs. Burnet gets to know you better during the year.

Possible Changes After the 10th Day of School

Teacher allotments are based on the number of students who show up within the first ten days of school. It is important to know that after the tenth day of school; we may need to make changes to class assignments due to an increase or decrease in student enrollment.

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Important Dates

1. August 22, 2019: Meet-the-Teacher Day for Grades 1-5 (4:00 pm - 6:00 pm).

- 5. September 3, 2019: First Day of School for all Kindergarten Students

Additional Information

- School Hours: 9:15 am 3:45 pm. Students may be dropped off as early as 8:45 am (first bell). The second bell rings at 9:10 followed by the tardy bell at 9:15. The instructional day begins promptly at 9:15 am. After 9:15, parents must sign their child in at the office.
- Carpool Morning Arrival: During arrival time (8:45-9:10), please follow the carpool line to the designated unloading zones in front of the building. When you reach the unloading zone, a staff member or safety patrol will open your car door to welcome you and let your child out. For the safety of all students and parents, please do not park and walk your child to the building. Also, please refrain from using your cell phone while in the carpool line.
- <u>Carpool Afternoon Dismissal</u>: Carpool tags must be displayed on your rearview mirror for pick-up. You may pick up a carpool tag during "Meet-the-Teacher" Day or at the main office at other times. You may use last year's carpool tags. To ensure a safe and smooth carpool dismissal, please adhere to the following carpool dismissal procedures:
 - 1. Hang carpool tag on rearview mirror.
 - 2. Follow the carpool line.
 - 3. Do not park and walk up to check your child out of carpool.
 - 4. Pull up to a designated loading zone.
 - 5. Students will be loaded by an adult or safety patrol.
 - 6. If you do not have a carpool tag, you will be asked to sign your child out at the main office.
 - 7. Refrain from using cell phones in the carpool line.



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- Early Arrival Program: Mills Park offers an on-site Before-School Care program run by Mills Park staff members. Enrolled students in the program may be dropped off as early as 7:00 am. The Before School program will begin on Monday, August 26, 2019. The cost per month for each child is \$96.25. You may enroll your child during Meet-the-Teacher Day. The non-refundable registration fee is \$15.00 per child.
- After School Program: The Northwest Cary YMCA runs an on-site After-School Care program at Mills Park ES, which will begin on Monday, August 26, 2019 from 3:45-6:00 PM. - **Bus Transportation:** If your child will be riding the bus from the same address to the same school next year, you do not need to take any action. If you need to update your bus service, please go online at www.wcpss.net/busrider. All bus routes will be posted online and communicated via SchoolMessenger on August 16th. Transportation will begin receiving requests for Dual Stops for Joint Custody, Alternate Stop (Before and After-School Care) and Transportation—Ineligible students on September 25th.
- Change of Transportation: Please send a note to your child's teacher if there is a change in transportation. If the teacher does not receive a note, your child will be sent home by his/her regular mode of transportation. If you forget to send a note and need your child's transportation changed, please call the school office before 1:00 pm.
- <u>Checking Students Out Early</u>: If you need to check your child out early for an appointment, please do so before 3:15 pm. The end of the day is a very busy time for us, so we would like to take care of early check-outs before 3:15 pm.
- <u>Tuesday Take-Home Folder</u>: Tuesday is the day when you will receive your child's work folder from school. Be sure to check book bags on Tuesdays for your child's schoolwork and any teacher/school communication.
- <u>Mills Park Monthly Principal Newsletter</u>: I will post my monthly principal's newsletter to the school website, http://millsparkes.wcpss.net/, on the last Tuesday of each month. It will provide you with important dates, events, and news for the upcoming month. Also, please refer to our school's Google calendar found on the school website for important dates and events.
