# **School Hours (9:15-3:45)**

Students may be dropped off as early as 8:45 am (first bell). The second bell rings at 9:10 followed by the tardy bell at 9:15. The instructional day begins promptly at 9:15 am. After 9:15, parents must sign their child in at the office using the Verkada visitor management system. If there are no adults at the carpool line, please do not drop your child off and leave without bringing them to the door to sign in.



# <u>Visiting the School – Verkada Visitor Management System</u>

All exterior doors will remain locked during the school day. When visiting the school, our front desk receptionist, Mrs. Mucciaccio, will routinely engage with you through the speaker before buzzing you into the building. The Verkada Management System is used district wide. To sign in, you will be asked to provide identifying information, including name, date of birth, and have your photo taken. For an easier check-in process, *please have your driver's license or state-approved ID from any state ready* each time you enter the building. Please make sure that as you enter the building you are not holding the door for others to enter behind you.

### **Carpool Morning Arrival**

During arrival time (8:45-9:10), please follow the carpool line to the designated unloading zones in front of the building. When you reach the unloading zone, a staff member or safety patrol will open your car door to welcome you and let your child out. For the safety of all students and parents, please do not park and walk your child into the building. Please drive slowly and follow the blue carpool line to ensure the safety of everyone.

## **Carpool Afternoon Dismissal**

Carpool tags must be displayed on your rearview mirror for pick-up. You may pick up a carpool tag during Meet- the- Teacher Day or at the main office at other times. Returning families may use last years' carpool number. To ensure a safe and smooth carpool dismissal, please adhere to the following carpool dismissal procedures:

- 1. Hang carpool tag on rearview mirror.
- 2. Follow the carpool line.
- 3. Do not park and walk up to check your child out of carpool.
- 4. Pull up to a designated loading zone.
- 5. Students will be loaded by an adult or safety patrol.
- 6. If you do not have a carpool tag, you will be asked to sign your child out at the main office.

#### **Early Arrival Program**

Mills Park offers an on-site Before-School Care program run by Mills Park staff members. Enrolled students in the program may be dropped off as early as 7:00 am. The Before School program will begin on Tuesday, August 27, 2024. The cost per month for each child is \$94.65. You may enroll your child during Meet-the-Teacher Day or online here. The non-refundable registration fee is \$15.00 per child.



# **After School Program**

The Northwest Cary YMCA runs an on-site After-School Care program at Mills Park ES, which will begin on Tuesday, August 27, 2024 from 3:45-6:00 PM. ### **Bus Transportation**

Families can find up-to-date transportation information (including route number, stop location, and estimated bus stop arrival times) in your student's <a href="Home Base/PowerSchool account">Home Base/PowerSchool account</a>. Notifications will start August 16th, 2024, for traditional schools. If your child(ren) plan to ride the school bus and were not assigned on August 16th, please complete this <a href="bus registration form">bus registration form</a> to ensure that they are assigned a bus route and bus stop.

# **Change of Transportation**

Please send a note to your child's teacher if there is a change in transportation. If the teacher does not receive a note, your child will be sent home by his/her regular mode of transportation. If you forget to send a note and need your child's transportation changed, please call the school office before 1:00 pm.

#### **Checking Students Out Early**

If you need to check your child out early for an appointment, please do so before 3:15 pm. The end of the day is a very busy time for us, so we would like to take care of early check-outs **before 3:15 pm**. We will utilize the Verkada visitor management system for early check-outs so please remember to bring your ID with you.

#### **Take-Home Folder**

Each child is assigned a take-home folder. This is the folder in which you will receive your child's work folder from school and any teacher/school communication.
