- Holly Grove Middle School Agenda (purchase from PTA first week of school)
- Binder(s) with pocket dividers to keep subjects separated. You may decide what works best for your child! It can be a binder for each subject, or one binder for all, as long as the paperwork can stay in order by subject.
- Spiral bound notebook with **pocket dividers** for Math notebook.
- 100 page marble composition book for Language Arts class.
- 100 page marble composition notebook for Science
- #2 pencils with erasers. **YOU WILL NEED A PENCIL EVERY SINGLE DAY THIS YEAR.** Please check with your child periodically to see if they need to restock their supply at school.
- Loose-leaf paper (keep in binder). Restock as needed throughout the year.
- Pencil Pouch with the following supplies:
  - Blue or black pens
  - Colored pencils/ small hand held pencil sharpener
  - Highlighters
  - Erasers
  - Glue Stick
  - Scissors
  - Scotch Tape-transparent
  - Sticky Notes and flag post-its needed for annotating in ELA
- Personal earbuds/earphones to leave at school for computer use
- Book bag that will fit into a 32x9.5x11" locker
- **A copy of the novel A Long Walk to Water by Linda Sue Park for 1st Quarter.**
- **A copy of the novel Lyddie by Katherine Paterson for 2nd Quarter.**
- **2 rolls of invisible tape refills (ELA) and 2 rolls for Mrs. Belles' science**
- Pack of 10 sheet protectors
