If your last year's teacher is not here, your previous or current teacher can complete this form. If you are new to Laurel Park, your current teacher can complete the form. The teachers will return this form to Mrs. Piezer, not the student. **Return this form to your homeroom teacher by no later than Friday, July 15th**. We can't wait to give our Penguins this exciting leadership opportunity! Safety Patrol members will be notified in writing and will start the week of July 25th.

Important points to remember:

- Safety Patrol lasts for the entire year and will be the week of July 25th.
- Morning duty begins at 8:40. You cannot be dropped off earlier than 8:40.
