 QUIZZES Points possible: 1-10 Quizzes are used as a quick checkpoint during a unit to ensure students are on track to being successful. 	 TESTS Points possible: 25-50 A minimum of two major assessments will be given each quarter. A project may be used in lieu of a unit test that will be graded the same as a test and be eligible for point recovery.
CLASSWORK 1-15 points HOMEWORK 1 point per assignment Assignments added individually to PS Checked for accuracy Classwork that needs to be completed after an in-person or virtual lesson is not considered homework and may be graded differently. 	 PROJECTS Points possible: 1-20 Points possible: 25 - 50 with point recovery if used in lieu of a unit test. Teachers will embed check-ins when projects extend for three or more days during the virtual learning phase.
 LATE WORK Late work will not be penalized. We will work to keep kids on deadlines, but flexibility will be given when circumstances arise. Graded work can be turned in until the end of a unit. Teachers will communicate when the end of a unit will occur. Zeroes will be placed in PS to show that work is missing, and zeroes will remain once a unit is completed. 	 POINT RECOVERY ON ASSESSMENTS Offered for all tests and projects of 25 points or higher when a student earns below 70% on the assessment. Students may earn UP TO a 70 (C) Available one time per assessment. Students will be asked to complete a study guide, attend a review session, or other activity to be eligible for point recovery.
