<ul> <li>QUIZZES</li> <li>Points possible: 1-10</li> <li>Quizzes are used as a quick checkpoint during a unit to ensure students are on track to being successful.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>TESTS</li> <li>Points possible: 25-50</li> <li>A minimum of two major assessments will be given each quarter.</li> <li>A project may be used in lieu of a unit test that will be graded the same as a test and be eligible for point recovery.</li> </ul>
CLASSWORK <ul> <li>1-15 points</li> <li>HOMEWORK</li> <li>1 point per assignment</li> <li>Assignments added individually to PS</li> <li>Checked for accuracy</li> <li>Classwork that needs to be completed after an in-person or virtual lesson is not considered homework and may be graded differently.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>PROJECTS</li> <li>Points possible: 1-20</li> <li>Points possible: 25 - 50 with point recovery if used in lieu of a unit test.</li> <li>Teachers will embed check-ins when projects extend for three or more days during the virtual learning phase.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>LATE WORK</li> <li>Late work will not be penalized. We will work to keep kids on deadlines, but flexibility will be given when circumstances arise.</li> <li>Graded work can be turned in until the end of a unit. Teachers will communicate when the end of a unit will occur.</li> <li>Zeroes will be placed in PS to show that work is missing, and zeroes will remain once a unit is completed.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>POINT RECOVERY ON ASSESSMENTS</li> <li>Offered for all tests and projects of 25 points or higher when a student earns below 70% on the assessment.</li> <li>Students may earn UP TO a 70 (C)</li> <li>Available one time per assessment.</li> <li>Students will be asked to complete a study guide, attend a review session, or other activity to be eligible for point recovery.</li> </ul>
