1 large canvas zipper pencil pouch. Please label with student's name. Following items need to go into the pencil pouch.

- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 packs of glue sticks (please put one pack in their container, send other pack in for class)
- 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons
- 2 highlighters, any color
- 1 pack of 3 pink erasers or pencil top erasers
- One Dry Board Eraser or dark colored sock

Other items needed but please do not put in pencil pouch:

- Headphones and please put their name on them
- Four-two pocket durable poly (**plastic**) folders. Please write your child's name on them in the upper right hand corner with <u>permanent marker</u>.
 - ➢ Blue: with 2 pockets
 - Red: with 2 pockets
 - ➤ Green: with prongs and 2 pockets
 - Yellow: with 2 pockets
- 1 pack of Ticonderoga pre-sharpened pencils. We will share them throughout the year.
- 3 wide rule spiral bound books: Word Work, Reading Response, and Math
- 2 wide rule marble composition books: Science and Writing
- Four dry erase markers; black only.
- Washable markers (8-10 count)
- 1 -1 inch binder(any color) and a set of 5 dividers labeled: Goals, Reading, Word Work, Writing, and Math
- 1 box of Clorox Wipes
- Girls- 1 box of gallon size Ziplock bags
- Boys- 1 box of sandwich size Ziplock bags
- 1 seasonally appropriate change of clothes in a large ziploc bag (keep in backpack)
