dear fourth grade families,

Items on this list are necessary for your child's organization and success in the classroom. Please bring **ONLY** the items listed. All supplies need to be at school on July 9th. If you have difficulty obtaining these items please let me know. I will do my best to assist you. The **bold** items are items that may need to be replenished midyear. Donation of **EXTRA** items is greatly appreciated!

•Pencil pouch with zipper (please label with student's name) NO PLASTIC BOXES

Supplies to go in the pencil pouch:

- ☐ Colored Pencils
- ☐ **4 Colored ballpoint pens**
- ☐ **1 package of 4 dry erase markers**
- ☐ Child safe scissors (Write your child's name on these)
- ☐ Highlighters
- ☐ **36 Pencils- no mechanical pencils (Ticonderoga or Dixon are best)**
- ☐ **8 glue sticks**
- ☐ 1 package of markers
- ☐ Backpack with your child's name in it

Other supplies:

- ☐ 1 One inch binder with pockets (no zipper binders)
- ☐ Dividers with pockets
- ☐ 2 spiral 3 subject notebooks (1 red, 1 green)
- ☐ 1 blue spiral 1 subject notebook
- ☐ 2 pads of sticky notes
- ☐ 1 package of sticky flags
- ☐ 2 packs of index cards
- ☐ **BOYS-** 1 pack of Clorox wipes, quart Ziploc bags (for classroom use)
- ☐ **GIRLS-** 1 box of Kleenex, gallon Ziploc bags (for classroom use)
- ☐ Headphones or ear buds in a Ziploc bag and labeled.
- ☐ Ruler

Please remove all packaging (except pencils and index cards) before sending to school.
