

Mrs. Shearin's Supply List First Grade Track 4




As the first day of school approaches, please don't forget the following important items: (Please label ALL of these items!) Thank you!


- 1. A standard sized book bag or backpack- no rolling backpacks please.
- 2. A seasonal change of clothes in a large Ziploc baggie labeled with your child's name on clothes & bag (include underwear & socks).
- 3. A lunch box, lunch money or a note saying that you have prepaid into a lunch account for your child (and their lunch number). PLEASE make sure your child knows what they're doing for lunch on their first day and thereafter.
- 4. A healthy snack packed SEPARATELY from their lunch and clearly labeled (please do <u>not</u> send candy). If your child goes to YMCA after school, make sure they have two snacks packed separately from one another and clearly labeled.
- 5.. 1 pair of Headphones labeled in a Ziploc bag.

Below is a list of school supplies I ask that you purchase and bring on Meet the Teacher (if you are able to),, but the first day of school will also work perfectly. Our class truly appreciates your generosity. If there is a problem obtaining any of these items, please let me know and we will make appropriate arrangements. (Please do not label these items)

4 Expo dry erase markers (color doesn't matter)

If you are a GIRL:

1 container of baby wipes (unscented)
1 pack Crayola markers (10 count)
