We have adjusted the Kindergarten schedule based on student engagement during the first quarter, and parent feedback. HOMWORK

All Kindergarten students are asked to complete 15 minutes of reading. This can include listening to an adult read or self selected books. All Kindergarten students are asked to complete at least one Dreambox lesson per day. Dreambox lessons help students practice math skills at their individual levels. There is flexibility within the day of when you complete practice assignments and HW.
