

Wearing a Face Covering to School



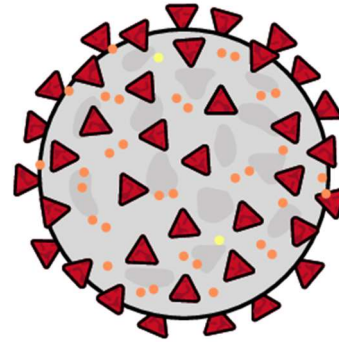
Kids and teachers can wear face coverings to school. This is new and different. It is okay.
