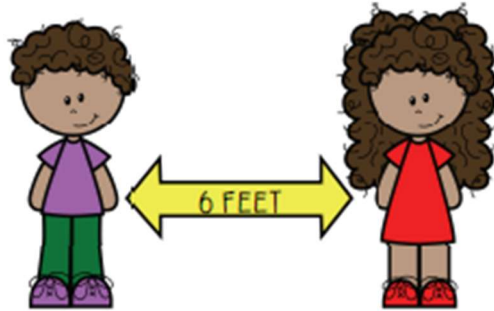


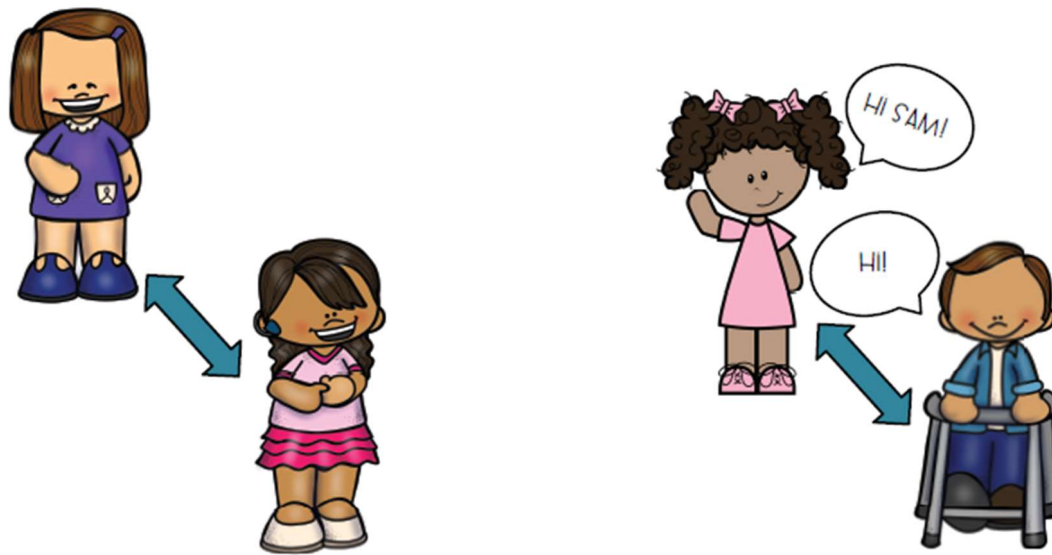
What is Social Distancing?

This will help keep everyone safe and healthy.



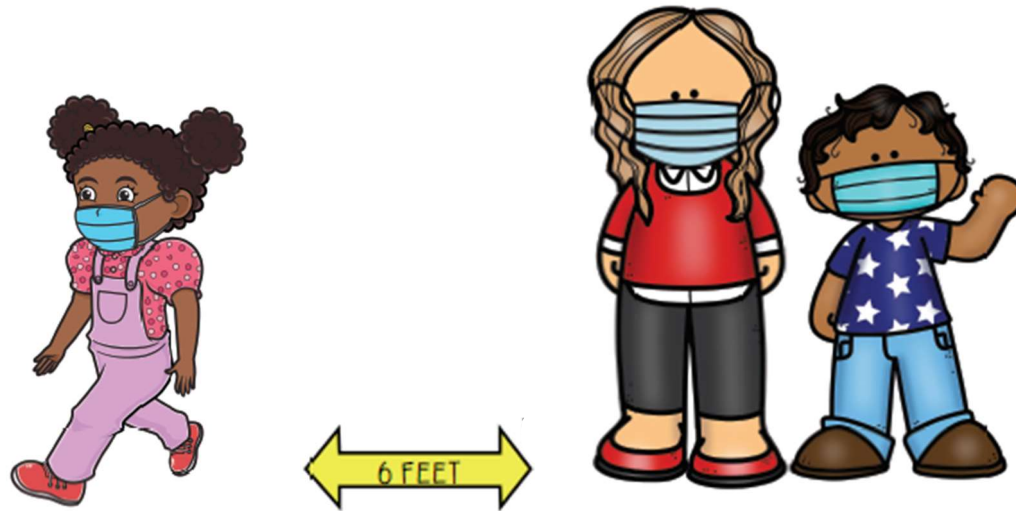
Social Distancing means giving space.
