- 1. Richard J. Murphy Memorial Scholarship**-Visionary Leader, Public Servant, Lifelong Learner. Richard J. Murphy embodied these traits as a teacher, an educator and an administrator during the 36 years he served the Wake County Public Schools. As the first principal of Leesville Road High School, which opened in 1993, his visionary leadership launched a top-notch school devoted to high standards for teachers and students and dedicated to exemplary performance in all aspects of curricular and extra-curricular activities.

The Murphy Scholarship recognizes Leesville Road High School seniors who embody the high expectations and commitment to visionary leadership, service, and lifelong learning that Richard Murphy epitomized and inspired others to achieve. Significant school involvement and a student's overall impact on LRHS are also important parts of the scholarship that will be considered in the selection process. Recipients of the Murphy Scholars Award will receive a **\$2,500** scholarship to use toward their college education. - 2. Leesville PTSA Scholarships** - The PTSA is offering two \$500 scholarships to Leesville seniors. The criteria for both are listed below:

PTSA Sherry Frost School Involvement Scholarship

- 2.5 or above weighted GPA
- School involvement
- One teacher recommendation
- Completion of an essay (topic is included on the application)

PTSA Academic Scholarship

- 3.7 (or above) weighted GPA
- School and community involvement
- One teacher recommendation
- Completion of an essay (topic is included on the application)

Applications for both scholarships are in the Student Services' Office. Completed materials must be returned to Student Services by **April 30**.

- 3. PRIDE Athletic Club, Jeff Sanders Memorial Scholarship**-This scholarship is in memory of Jeff Sanders, a parent of Leesville athletes Sara and Thomas, who also volunteered countless hours to the Leesville athletics program and facilities over many years. Two **\$1000** scholarships will be awarded, one to a male athlete and one to a female athlete.

Scholarship Requirements:

- Have participated in a varsity sport their senior year as a player, manager, trainer, statistician or sports medicine student.
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Have an exemplary discipline and attendance record
- Planning to attend some form of higher education
- Recommendation from the coach of your sport

Applications are in the Student Services Office and are due back to Student Services by **April 30**.

- 4. Loomis, Rose and Ruth Peebles Scholarship**-This scholarship is open to African American graduating seniors that plan to attend NC State, UNC-Chapel Hill, UNCG, UNCA, UNCW, UNCC, UNCP, East Carolina, Davidson, Elon or Duke. Applications can be accessed at www.nccommunityfoundation.org and searching for the scholarship by name. The deadline is May 3.
- 5. NCACTE Guidance and Career Development Scholarship**-This scholarship is open to a graduating senior who have completed a CTE Concentrator course of study. Seniors who have completed a CTE Concentrator can apply at: <https://ncacte.wufoo.com/forms/se4exsw1b39oji/> The deadline to Apply is April 15.
- 6. State Employees Association of North Carolina Scholarship**- Each year, SEANC, offers academic scholarships to the children of SEANC members. For information and an application, go to: <http://www.seanc.org/membership/scholarship/>. The deadline to apply is April 15.
- 7. NC Society of Accountants Scholarship** - This \$750 scholarship is for any senior planning to study accounting in college. Applications and Instructions are in the Student Services' Office. The deadline to apply is April 15.
- 8. Wake Tech Foundation Scholarships**- These scholarships are open to any student planning to attend Wake Tech and based on financial need and academic performance. Go to: scholarships.waketech.edu to apply. The deadline is April 30.
- 9. Couch Oil Cares Scholarship**-This \$1000 scholarship is available to students who have been accepted into either a four year or community college. The application involves teacher recommendations and the completion of two essays. The deadline to apply is June 21. - 10. Miss Margaret Scholarship** is open to any girl who will graduate from an accredited high school in Wake County, who expects to enroll in an institution of higher education this fall, and who meets the eligibility requirements. This is a one-year (non-renewable) scholarship. The "Miss Margaret" Scholarship is sponsored by the Alpha Theta Chapter of the North Carolina Alpha Delta Kappa, an international sorority for women educators. - 11. Future Educator Scholarship**-The Future Educator Scholarship is open to any student who will graduate from an accredited high school in Wake County, who expects to enroll in an institution of higher education next fall with a degree in education, and who meets the eligibility requirements. This scholarship is a one-time (non-renewable) scholarship in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500). The Future Educator Scholarship is sponsored by the Alpha Theta Chapter of the North Carolina Alpha Delta Kappa, an international sorority for

12. **Jane Smith/Brenda Marbell Scholarship**- This scholarship is open to seniors in Wake County who are in the top 25% of their class, have community service and plan to attend college. Applications are in the Student Services Office and the deadline to apply is April 13.
13. **Society of American Military Engineers Scholarship**-This scholarship available to senior planning to study engineering, architecture or construction management in college. Applications are in the Student Services Office and the deadline to apply is April 24.
14. **Robert Franklin Black Scholarship**-This scholarship is for a graduating senior who plans to attend college and has overcome extreme adversity in their life.
