



WHAT IS CAREER AND COLLEGE PROMISE?

[Career & College Promise](#) (CCP) is North Carolina's dual enrollment program for high school students. This program allows eligible NC high school students to enroll in tuition-free college classes at North Carolina community colleges while still in high school. Students who successfully complete these college courses earn college credit they can take with them after graduation in many cases. (Please note that not all colleges may accept these courses for transfer credit and students should research any college of interest's process for transferring credits.)

CCP offers students the option to choose from these pathways:

- [College Transfer](#) - Designed for students planning to continue their educational career beyond high school to eventually achieve an Associate's or Bachelor's degree at a community college or university. -Use this [link](#) to decide which pathway best fits your college/career plans. (Click the dropdown arrow under Wake Tech Degrees to learn more about each pathway)
- [Career & Technical Education](#) - Allows students to begin a certification or diploma program in a particular technical field or career area.

*Students can take up to two pathways, but if they do, one must be a Career and Technical Education pathway.

We recommend starting this program in the fall of junior year. This provides 6 semesters to participate (Fall, Spring, and Summer of Junior and Senior years) Please use this [link](#) to determine eligibility in the program.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

- Please visit Wake Tech's [website](#) to review their steps for applying. (New & Returning Students) The [CCP New Student Application User Guide](#) and [CCP Continuing Student Form User Guides](#) are helpful when applying.
- When applying, you should apply prior to the semester you want to begin (e.g. if you plan to start in fall 2023 you should apply during spring 2023). Students will register for summer and/or fall courses in the spring. (Check the [Events and Important Deadlines](#) page for more information)
- You will need a recent copy of your academic transcript for CCP. To request a transcript, please email Mr. Greene, egreene@wcpss.net from your school email.
- Once you have completed and submitted your application, you will receive an Eligibility

Verification (EV) Form from Wake Tech. All students should list **Eric Greene**, Dean of Students (egreene@wcpss.net) as the principal/designee on the Wake Tech EV form.

- Some students choose to have a reduced day at LRHS to make time for CCP classes but you do not have to do this. CCP courses can be taken in addition to your LRHS course load.
- **Spring Semester Information:** As you register for classes at LRHS for the **23-24 school year**, you will follow the exact same process as normal. Sign up for 8 primary classes and 4 alternates.
- If you would like to “drop” a class to modify your schedule, please drop off your completed Release Time Form to the receptionist in Student Services by April 28.

PLEASE NOTE:

- ✓ Wake Tech’s calendar does **NOT** align with the WCPSS calendar. These are two separate institutions. There may be overlapping classes/dates at the beginning and end of semesters. Plan accordingly when registering with Wake Tech.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do CCP courses impact my high school GPA?

[College Transfer Pathway](#): Courses that are 3 semester hours of credit and above carry 1 extra quality point added towards the high school GPA. Courses taken under this pathway **WILL** be added to your high school transcript, regardless of grade received.

[Career & Technical Education](#) - Courses of 3 semester hours of credit and above in the CTE area typically add 0.5 points to your GPA. Students may email Mr. Greene for clarification on each class.

Which pathway should I choose to be in?

What are the guidelines for Sports Eligibility?

To remain eligible to play a sport at LRHS, you must be enrolled in at least 3 classes the semester prior to the season of your sport. For example, if you play a spring sport, you must be enrolled in at least 3 classes during the fall semester, this can be a combination of LRHS classes and CCP classes.

How do I search for a course before I am admitted?

Available course sections/times/teachers/textbook information is public information and can be found by anyone here (even without an account):

- [Wake Tech WebAdvisor](#)
 - Click “Future Students”
 - Click “Admissions Information:
 - Click “Search for curriculum sections”
 - In “Term,” select the term you wish to take classes.
 - In “Subject,” put the Course Abbreviation - ex. Psychology is PSY
 - In “Course Number,” put the number next to the abbreviation - ex. 150 - PSY “150”
 - Scroll Down and click “Submit”
 - All sections will appear
 - If there aren’t any seats available for the course, you can not attempt to register for it
