Career & College Promise

Wake Tech's Career & College Promise (CCP) program offers eligible high school students the opportunity to earn credits toward a college degree or a credential for employment – tuition-free. In many cases, students earn dual credit, meeting high school graduation requirements with college courses.

CCP offers students the opportunity to explore more than 40 academic programs, saving them and their families money on college tuition while also lightening their future course load in college. Students get a feel of the "college experience," and they can boost their admissions profile by demonstrating they are ready for the rigors of college-level classes.

For students not interested in pursuing a college degree, CCP provides a jump-start to career plans, job training, skills and certifications.

Starting Points to Apply for the CCP Program

- The requirement for students in grades 11 and 12 to take CCP Classes is an unweighted GPA of at least 2.8.

- Students will need a recent copy of their transcript for CCP. To request a transcript, please email **Mr. Greene, egreene@wcpss.net** from your school email.
- When completing the application, ALL students should list **Mr. Greene, egreene@wcpss.net**, as the principal/designee on the Wake Tech forms. **DO NOT LIST THE PRINCIPAL'S EMAIL ADDRESS.**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How are course weighted in dual enrollment?

College Transfer Pathway – The College Transfer classes carry an additional 1.0 credit weight on your GPA. All courses taken in this pathway will be added to your transcript - whatever you earn at Wake Tech, is what is added to your transcript at LRHS. **No matter the outcome!**

Career and Technical Education Pathway – Most of these classes carry the same GPA points as your high school classes: (standard = 0 added, honors = 0.5 added, college = 1.0 point added). Courses taken from this chart WILL be added to your high school transcript. **No matter the outcome!**

What happens if I drop my CCP Class?

You MUST inform Mr. Greene as soon as you drop the class. Unless there are extenuating circumstances, you will receive a WF (withdraw failing) on your LRHS transcript for dropping the CCP class after the first 10 days of class based on the LRHS, calendar, either 1st or 2nd semester.
