CCP offers two pathways, depending on a student's goals.

- The Career and Technical Education Pathway (CTE) leads to a credential for employment (certificate, diploma, or degree).
- The College Transfer Pathway (CT) leads to credit hours that count toward a two-year associate's degree at Wake Tech and align with course requirements at UNC member institutions.
- When completing the CCP forms online, all students should enter Mr. Greene's email as the contact person for LRHS. His email is egreene@wcpss.net.
- Students should email Mr. Greene from their school email to receive a transcript for their application.
- Grades from CCP classes **DO** go on your high school transcript.
