- 4. On the 1st and 2nd day back, **only** students with a scheduled EOC should report to campus.
- 5. Students should speak with their math teacher if they are unclear on which day they should take the Math I EOC.
- 6. Make-up exams will be administered by appointment with the teacher.
- 7. Students must be present at the beginning of each exam period to take the exam. Students must be present for the entire exam period to receive credit for the exam.
