Graduation Requirements	
 English	<b>4 Credits</b> English I, II, III, IV
Math	<b>4 Credits</b> Math 1,2, and 3 and a 4 <sup>th</sup> math to be aligned with the student's post high school plans. (To meet minimum admission requirements for the UNC system, the 4 <sup>th</sup> math must be one of the following: Discrete Math, Math IV, AP PreCalculus, AP Statistics or AP Calculus) <b>In the rare instance a principal exempts a student from the FRC math sequence, the student would be required to pass Common Core Math I and II and two other application-based math courses.</b> <small>*N.C.G.S. 115C-81(b) allows exceptions for students who have an IEP (Individualized Education Plan) that identifies them as Learning Disabled in math and states that the disability will prevent them from mastering Common Core Math I and above</small>
Science	<b>3 Credits</b> A Physical Science course (Chemistry, Physical Science, Physics) Biology, and an Earth/Environmental Science
Social Studies	<b>4 Credits</b> For Current Seniors-World History, American History I and II (or American I or II and a social studies elective or AP US History and one additional Social Studies elective) and Civics and Economics For current 9 <sup>th</sup> , 10 <sup>th</sup> , 11 <sup>th</sup> grade students-World History, Civic Literacy, American History (or AP US
