Notes:

1. For all courses, the final exam is worth 20% of the student's final grade. This includes End-of-Course (EOC) Exams, Career and Technical Education (CTE), or Teacher-Made Assessments. Assessments are required for all courses.

- 2. Teachers giving a teacher-made assessment have the option of assessing students through a traditional exam on January 10 and 11, or through a project-based assessment assigned ahead of time or presented on January 10 and 11. It is the responsibility of the teacher to clearly communicate with students about the expectations of this assessment. Should attendance on January 10 and 11 not be required, students need not attend.
- 3. Students must be present at the beginning of each exam period to take the exam, should a traditional exam be assigned. Students must plan to be present for the **entire exam period**. **Students will not have access to cell phones during their exam period**.
- 4. Students should only attend exam periods on January 10 and 11 if an exam is required. On January 12 and January 13, **only** students with a scheduled EOC should report to campus. On January 14, **only** students with a scheduled make up exam should report to campus.
- 5. Virtual Academy students are still required to take state exams on campus. Wherever possible, smaller settings will be utilized to test Virtual Academy students.
- 6. **Seniors** with a C or better in a course with a teacher made exam can be exempt from the final exam. Seniors **cannot** be exempt from CTE or EOC exams.
- 7. Math 1, Math 1B, Math 3, Math 3 Honors, English 2, English 2 Honors, English 2 PreAP will review during their assigned class period on Monday, January 10 or Tuesday, January 11 and will take the NC End of Course Test (EOC) as scheduled on Wednesday, January 12 or Thursday, January 13.
- 8. **Buses** will run at 1:15 on Monday, January 10 and Tuesday January 11. Buses will run at 12:00 on Wednesday, January 12, Thursday, January 13, and Friday, January 14.
- 9. Make-up teacher-made exams will be administered by appointment with the teacher.
- 10. Students who are on campus during an exam period for which they do not have an exam on January 12 or 13 must report to ISS in Room 201.
- 11. The campuses of Leesville Road Elementary School and Leesville Road Middle School, as well as other Wake County schools, are strictly off limits on these dates to Leesville Road High School students.
