Notes:

1. **For all courses, the final exam is worth 20% of the student's final grade. This includes End-of-Course (EOC) Exams, Career and Technical Education (CTE) State Assessments, or Teacher-Made Exams. Exams are required for all courses.**
2. **Seniors** with a C or better in a course with a teacher made exam can be exempt from the final exam. Seniors **cannot** be exempt from CTE state assessments or EOC exams.
3. Teachers giving a teacher-made assessment have the option of assessing students through a traditional exam on January 23 and 24 or through a project-based assessment assigned ahead of time or presented on January 23 and 24. It is the responsibility of the teacher to clearly communicate with students about the expectations of this assessment. Should attendance on January 23 and 24 not be required, students need not attend.
4. For classes with a traditional exam, students must be present at the beginning of each exam period to take the exam and must be present for the **entire exam period** to receive credit for the exam. **Students will not have access to cell phones during the exam period.**
5. On January 20, **only** students with a scheduled EOC should report to campus. On January 25 and 26, **only** students with a scheduled makeup exam should report to campus.
6. Students should only attend exam periods on January 23 and 24 if an exam is required. Students who are on campus during an exam period for which they do not have an exam on January 23 or 24 must report to their assigned classroom for that class period.
7. **Buses** will run at 2:18 on Friday, January 20, Wednesday, January 25, and Thursday, January 26. Buses will run at 1:15 on Monday, January 23 and Tuesday, January 24.
8. **Make-up teacher-made exams** will be administered by appointment with the teacher.
9. The campuses of Leesville Road Elementary School and Leesville Road Middle School, as well as other Wake County schools, are strictly off limits on these dates to Leesville Road High School students.
