- Summer School students will be completing all classes through remote learning this year.
- Summer School is only for repeat credit. The student must have previously failed or received a WC-19 in the class. Some courses are not offered for students only with WC-19 status. Those are noted below. These courses are taken as pass/fail; no numerical grade will be rewarded.
- Summer School students who attain graduate status because of Summer School can attend a Graduation Ceremony on August 12 at 7 PM at Enloe High School, should circumstances allow for a graduation ceremony.
- Completing this application does not guarantee a student a spot in Summer School.
- Notification of acceptance or denial of a summer school spot will be through EMAIL. Parents
 and students MUST supply an email account that is active and is checked on a regular basis.
