This bulletin is not meant to be an all-inclusive list of scholarship information. It only contains information on scholarships that we have actually received at the school. It often does not contain college/university specific scholarships, unless it is a college/university scholarship that requires a specific nomination from Leesville. Students are encouraged to look at the websites for the colleges to which they are applying for specific scholarship information.

- 1. **The Raleigh Engineer's Club Scholarship**-This scholarship is for students who plan to attend the School of Engineering at NC State. It will cover one semester of tuition. The application can be found at: http://www.raleighengineersclub.org/. The deadline to apply is April 19.
- 2. **Michelle B. Vitale Memorial Scholarship** The Michelle B. Vitale Trust is proud to offer an annual scholarship in memory of Michelle B. Vitale, a former teacher at Leesville Road High School. Ms. Vitale dedicated her life to working with children of all ages. The criteria for the \$1000 scholarship are:
 - Plans for further education as a full-time student
 - Plans to pursue a degree in Education
 - Current GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - Two letters of recommendation from LRHS Staff members

Applications for this scholarship are in the Student Services' Office. Completed applications with attached letters of recommendation and other requested information should be returned to Student Services by **April 1.**

- 3. **Robert N. Styres Scholarship** This \$4000 renewable scholarship will be awarded to one Wake County High School senior planning to attend college. The scholarship is based on academics with a special focus on a hardworking student who may have overcome adversity along the way. Leesville can submit only one applicant for this scholarship. Interested students should pick up an application in Student Services and return the completed application to Student Services by **March 25.** Once the one nominee is selected, the school will send the application and a transcript.
- 4. **Hammond Hill Scholarship-** This \$2000 scholarship is open to any senior who is planning to major in education. Applications are in the Student Services Office and the deadline to apply is April 1.
- 5. Raleigh-Wake Chapter of the Winston Salem State University Alumni Association Memorial Scholarship-This scholarship is for a graduating senior planning to attend WSSU. Requirements and the application can be found at: http://www.raleighwakewssunaa.org/ The deadline to apply is April 1.
- 6. **State Employees Association of North Carolina Scholarship** Each year, SEANC, offers academic scholarships to the children of SEANC members. For information and an application, go to: http://www.seanc.org/membership/scholarship/. The deadline to apply is April 15.
- 7. **Raleigh Optimist Club Scholarship**-Two scholarships are being offered by the Raleigh Optimist Club for graduating seniors who are planning to continue their education after high school. Applications can be found at: www.raleigh-optimist.org. Applications must be postmarked by March 25.

8. **Hugh Morson Memorial Scholarship**- This scholarship is open to any senior planning to attend college, has at least a 2.5 GPA and has demonstrated traits of high personal character and leadership. Applications can be found at: https://www.csascholars.org/mrsn/index.php and the deadline to apply is March 29.
