- 1. Zeta Phi Beat Sorority Scholarship-Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. is an international public service sorority that is comprised of over 250,000 predominately African American women. Encouraging youth to achieve excellence through higher education is a primary focus of their organization. They support this focus by awarding scholarships to young people who exemplify academic excellence, strong leadership, and community involvement. - 9. **Hugh Morson Memorial Scholarship-** This scholarship is open to any senior planning to attend college, has at least a 2.5 GPA and has demonstrated traits of high personal character and leadership. - 10. Robert Franklin Black Scholarship-Recipients will be chosen based on financial need, academic achievement, and overcoming adversity encountered by the applicant. The individual must have applied to and be planning to attend an accredited institution of higher learning within one year of the application deadline.
