

LRHS Scholarship Bulletin March 2023

This bulletin is not meant to be an all-inclusive list of scholarship information. It only contains information on scholarships that we have received at the school. - 1. Alpha Delta Kappa-Alpha Delta Kappa is an International Sorority for women educators. They are offering three scholarships for students interested in the field of education. The deadline for all the scholarships is April 28.
 - The Future Educator Scholarship (\$500) is open to any student who will graduate from an accredited public high school in Wake County, who expects to enroll in an institution of higher education next fall to pursue a degree in education and/or enroll in a teacher preparation program, and who meets the eligibility requirements.  - The **Miss Margaret Scholarship (\$500)** is open to any young woman who will graduate from an accredited public high school in Wake County, who expects to enroll in an institution of higher education this fall, and who meets the eligibility requirements.  - The **Miss Abigail Scholarship (\$1,000)** is open to any student who will graduate from a WCPSS high school, who expects to enroll in an institution of higher education next fall, and who meets the eligibility requirements. One of the requirements is that the applicant must have a family member who is a current or former educator. (The family member does not have to be in their immediate family.) - 2. **Hammond Hill-**The local Beta Omicron Chapter of Alpha Delta Kappa is offering one or more scholarships of at least \$2000 to a Wake County Public School System senior who plans to enter the field of Education. The application can be found <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is April 10.
- 3. **Maude P.** McInnes Scholarship-This \$500 scholarship is offered by the Wake County Cooperative Extension Service and is geared toward students who are interested in Family Consumer Science in College. The deadline is March 27 and the applications can be found <u>HERE</u>.
- 4. **Christine Council Foundation Scholarship-** Christine Council was a devoted mother, grandmother and friend who lost her battle with breast cancer in 2003. Her son graduated from LRHS, and this \$2000 scholarship is in her memory. Documents required for this scholarship are:
 - A minimum 2.8 GPA
 - A transcript
 - A college acceptance letter
 - One-to-two-page personal statement including personal history, education, and career goals. In this essay, applicants must exhibit determination, community service and resilience.
 - One letter of recommendation from teacher, coach, or community leader.

All required documents must be emailed to <u>christinecouncilscholarship@gmail.com</u>. The deadline is March 31. Mr. Greene, <u>egreene@wcpss.net</u>, is willing to help students compile these documents and assist in sending them.

- 5. Alliance of Black School Educators of Wake County Scholarship- This scholarship is open to African American Seniors planning to attend college in the fall of 2023. The deadline is April 3, and the application can be found <u>HERE</u>.
- 6. **Phebe Harlan Emmons Scholarship-**This \$1000 scholarship is open to a female who is planning to attend a college in NC and majoring in education. The application can be found <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is April 14.

- 7. Phi Lambda Educational Scholarship-This \$1000 scholarship is open to African American Males with good scholastic and leadership records who plan to attend a 4-year college. Applications can be found <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is April 15.
- 8. Couch Oil Cares Scholarship-This \$1000 scholarship is available to students who have been accepted into either a four year or community college. The application involves teacher recommendations and the completion of two essays. The deadline to apply is May 5. Applications can be found <u>HERE</u>.
- 9. Woman's Club of Raleigh Scholarship-This organization is offering two \$1000 scholarships to seniors in Raleigh who plan to attend a North Carolina College. The application can be found <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is April 2.
- 10. Hearing Loss Association of America Scholarship-This \$500 scholarship is open to a Wake County Senior with a hearing loss. The application can be found <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is March 31.
- 11. **The Raleigh Engineers Club Scholarship-**This scholarship is for students who plan to attend the School of Engineering at NC State. The application can be found <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is April 21.
- 12. **Robert N. Styres Scholarship-** This \$4000 renewable scholarship will be awarded to one Wake County High School senior planning to attend college. The scholarship is based on academics with a special focus on a diligent student who may have overcome adversity along the way. Leesville can submit only one applicant for this scholarship. The application is in the Student Services Office. Completed applications should be returned to Mr. Greene by March 24.
- Hugh Morson Memorial Scholarship- This scholarship is open to any senior planning to attend college, has at least a 2.5 GPA and has demonstrated traits of high personal character and leadership. Applications can be found <u>HERE</u>. the deadline to apply is March 30.
- 14. **Robert Franklin Black Scholarship**-Recipients will be chosen based on financial need, academic achievement, and overcoming adversity encountered by the applicant. The individual must have applied to and be planning to attend an accredited institution of higher learning within one year of the application deadline. Applications can be found <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is April 15.
- 15. William Gaston Allen Scholarship- This scholarship is open to any senior who has at least a 2.0 GPA who is planning to go to a 2- or 4-year college. Details can be found <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is March 30.
- 16. Raleigh-Wake Chapter of the Winston Salem State University Alumni Association Memorial Scholarship-This scholarship is for a graduating senior planning to attend WSSU. Requirements and the application can be <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is April 1.
- 17. State Employees Association of North Carolina Scholarship- Each year, SEANC, offers academic scholarships to the children of SEANC members. For information and an application, go <u>HERE</u>. The deadline to apply is April 15.
- 18. Student-View Scholarship Program-The 2022 Student-View Scholarship Program is offering \$12,000 worth of scholarships to high school seniors who plan to attend a four-year college, community/junior college, or career school. Go <u>HERE</u> and complete a 15-20-minute application survey about colleges in your area. The scholarship will be awarded via a random drawing of all completed applications. The deadline is April 23.
- 19. **McNair-Harris Crescent Foundation Scholarship Application** The McNair-Harris Crescent Foundation has been able to award scholarships to students annually for the past 25 years. This Foundation offers a \$500 scholarship to graduating male seniors. The application can be found <u>HERE</u>. The deadline is April 14.
