

## LRHS Scholarship Bulletin October 2019

This bulletin is not meant to be an all inclusive list of scholarship information. It only contains information on scholarships that we have actually received at the school. It often does not contain college/university specific scholarships, unless it is a college/university scholarship that requires a specific nomination from Leesville. Students are encouraged to look at the websites for the colleges to which they are applying for specific scholarship information.

1. NC State Centennial Scholarship – The Centennial Scholarship is directed towards students interested in the areas of engineering, business management, chemistry, polymer chemistry, international studies, design, apparel sourcing, fashion merchandising or retail management. Applicants should have an interest and willingness to enter the Textile degree program. Selection is based upon high academic achievement throughout high school, proven and potential leadership qualities, extracurricular activities and unique life experiences. Leesville can nominate two students. Interested students must first apply to NC State by November 1 and then email a resume to Mr. Greene (egreene@wcpss.net) by October 28 to be considered for nomination. - 2. Raleigh Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship-The Elks National Foundation will award 500 fouryear scholarships to the highest-rated applicants. - 4. UNC-Chapel Hill Thomas Wolfe Scholarship- This award is for seniors who have a strong interest in attending UNC-Chapel Hill and pursuing a major in English/Creative Writing. - 5. Davidson College John Montgomery BELK Scholarship- Belk Scholars are those students whose outstanding intellectual ability and success, leadership experience, commitment to service, and overall personal vigor mark them as those who will accomplish much and contribute most to the Davidson community and in their lives beyond their college years. Davidson awards only eight of these scholarships each year. Leesville may nominate two students for this scholarship. Interested seniors should email Mr. Greene (egreene@wcpss.net) a copy of their resume by October 25 to be considered. - 6. Robertson Scholars Program-This scholarship is collaboration between UNC Chapel Hill and Duke University. Criteria include high academic standards, leadership potential, public service and interest in diversity of people and cultures in and outside USA. Applicants are encouraged to submit materials online at www.robertsonscholars.org. The deadline to apply is November 15.

- 7. Ron Brown Scholarship Program-This national program recognizes and awards scholarships to academically talented, highly motivated African American high school seniors who plan to attend a four-year university. Applicants must exhibit excellence, leadership, commitment to public and a desire to make a difference. Financial need must exist as well. Go to www.ronbrown.org for more details. The early application deadline is November 1.
- 8. Coca-Cola Scholars-Each year this program awards 250 merit-based scholarships to seniors across the country. This award is open to any senior. You must apply for this scholarship via the Internet. Go to <a href="http://www.coca-colascholars.org">www.coca-colascholars.org</a> and follow the instructions. Students will need Leesville's CEEB code, which is 343214. The deadline to apply is October 31.
- **9.** Horatio Alger Association Scholarship-This association recognizes students who have demonstrated integrity, perseverance in overcoming adversity, strength of character and financial need. Applicants must have at least a 2.0 GPA and plan to attend either a 2-year or 4-year school. The application is available at: <u>https://scholars.horatioalger.org/scholarships/</u>. Deadlines vary dependent on the scholarship.
