NC ACADEMIC SCHOLARS REQUIREMENTS

GPA: 3.5 –UNWEIGHTED*

*** This cumulative GPA includes 3rd quarter grades of senior year. So it may be a different GPA than the one you had up through the end of 1st semester.**

English: 4 credits

English I, II, III, and IV

Math: 4 credits

Math I, Math II, Math III and a higher level math course with Math III as a prerequisite

Science: 3 credits

Biology, Chemistry or Physics,
and an Earth/Environmental Science course

Social Studies: 4 credits

World History, Civics and Economics, American History I and II,
or AP US History and one more Social Studies elective

Healthful Living: 1 credit

Second Language: 2 credits

Level I and Level II of the same language

Honors/AP Electives: 3 credits*

3 Higher level classes (Honors or AP) taken during the junior or senior year.

***(Classes already counted under English, Math, Science, Social Studies and Second Language cannot be used twice to meet the Honors/AP electives for junior and senior year)**
