JUNIORS may attend in the areas of English, Mathematics, Natural Science, Social Science, French, Spanish, Drama, Visual Arts, Choral Music, Instrumental Music, or Dance.

ELIGIBILITY: All students must have a 3.75 unweighted GPA for areas in academics or a 3.5 unweighted GPA for areas in Arts.
